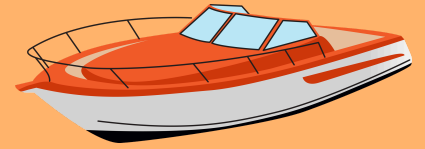

New State Law: Engine cut-off switch links are required on smaller boats operated in Delaware waters.



Engine Cut Off Switch Links

As of January 2026, engine cut-off switch links are required on certain smaller boats operated in Delaware waters.

An engine cut-off switch (ECOS) is a safety device that immediately stops a vessel's engine when activated, typically by disconnecting the operator's link. An ECOS link is a physical or wireless connection used to attach the operator to the engine cut-off switch installed on the vessel.

Under state law, no one may operate a vessel less than 26 feet in length, and capable of developing 115 pounds of thrust or 3 horsepower, while on plane or above a slow-no-wake speed unless the operator is wearing an ECOS link.

This regulation may not apply if the main helm of the vessel is installed within an enclosed cabin, or if the vessel or outboard engine was manufactured prior to 2020 and was not equipped with an ECOS.

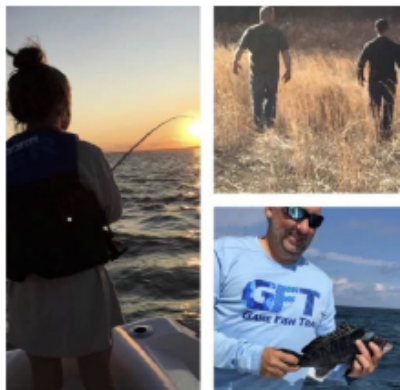

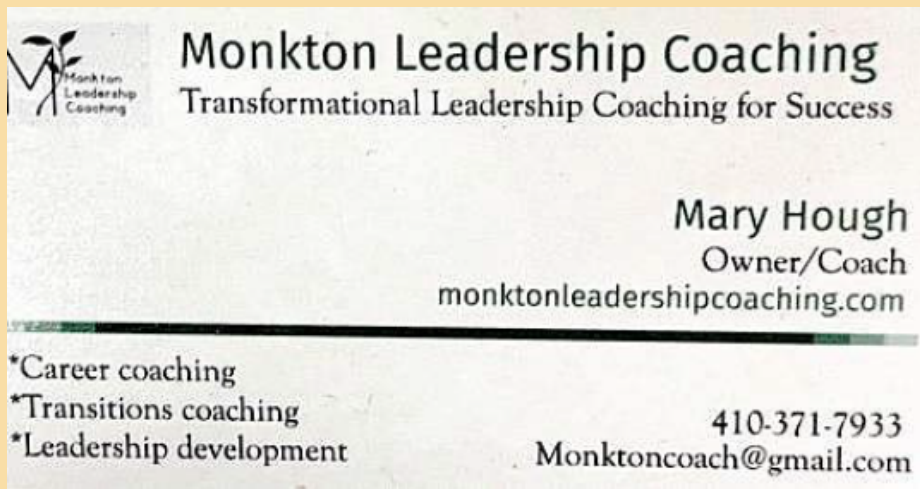

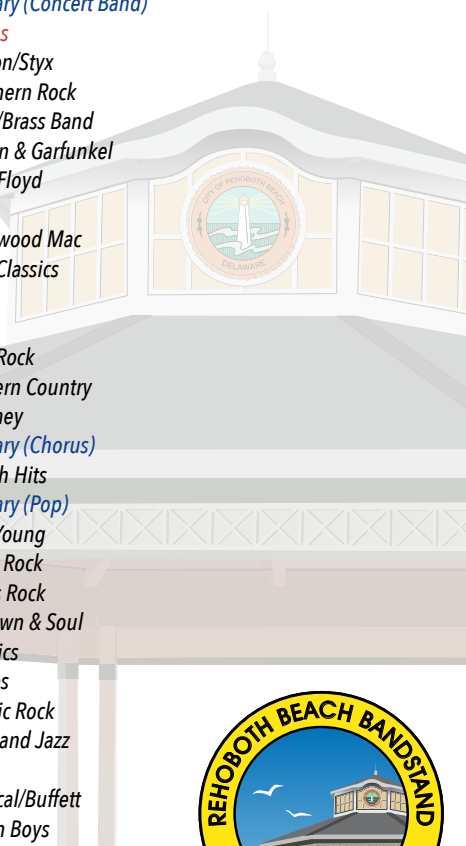
