

# **Tri-Tip with Chimichurri**

The tri-tip is a tender, triangular cut of beef tucked near the sirloin. There are only two per steer, so if your butcher is out, go with sirloin.

#### **Ingredients**

#### 6 Servings

1 tablespoon sesame seeds

1 tablespoon smoked paprika

2 tablespoons plus 1/2 cup olive oil

2 teaspoons kosher salt, plus more

2 teaspoons freshly ground black pepper, plus more

2 pounds tri-tip steak or two 1-pound sirloin steaks

2 garlic cloves, finely grated

2 cups finely chopped parsley

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cup finely chopped cilantro

1/4 cup red wine vinegar

1 tablespoon agave nectar

#### **Preparation**

#### Step 1

Mix sesame seeds, paprika, 2 Tbsp. oil, 2 tsp. salt, and 2 tsp. pepper in a small bowl to combine. Rub all over steak and let sit at room temperature 30 minutes.

#### Step 2

Meanwhile, prepare a grill for medium-high, indirect heat (for a charcoal grill, bank coals on one side of grill; for a gas grill, leave one or two burners off). Place steak over indirect heat, cover grill, and grill, turning once, until an instant-read thermometer inserted into the thickest part of steak registers 115°, 20–30 minutes. Move steak to direct heat and grill until lightly charred, about 2 minutes per side, or until an instant-read thermometer registers 120° for medium-rare (temperature will continue to rise off heat). Transfer to a cutting board and let rest 10 minutes before slicing against the grain.

#### Step 3

While steak is resting, combine garlic, parsley, cilantro, vinegar, agave nectar, and remaining  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup oil; season with salt and pepper. Serve steak with chimichurri

## **Beach Mason Jar**

#### Supplies:

- Mason jar
- Americana Decou-Page
- Broken seashells or faux rock vase filler
- Brush
- Twine
- Flameless tea light candles
- painters tape (optional)

# **DIY Seashell Mason Jar**

- To make the jars apply a generous amount of decoupage glue on the mason jar, working in sections.
- Allow glue to fully dry before turning to another section or the rocks may slide off. It takes about 20-30 minutes for each section to dry. Another tip is to make sure you have a single layer of the shells so that they adhere to the jar well.
- Once the mason jars are dry, tie twine around the mouth of the jar and add a tea light inside.
