In September of 2023, 120,000 Armenian people were forced to leave their ancestral homeland of Artsakh, leaving behind their homes and heritage to the dictatorial regime of Azerbaijan. This genocidal act is aimed towards erasing the Armenian presence and culture in the region. Music for Unity protests such crimes against humanity through the powerful voice of music! The *HOMECOMING/Return to Artsakh* project is inspired by our belief that "all displaced persons have the right to return to their homes," as stated by The Council of Europe Commissioner for Human Rights, Dunja Mijatović.
