CALMER CLAPPING AND FILING OUT OF THE ROOM.

ANNE

Sorry you can't celebrate with us Bass. All of this. . .all the praise and rewards are due to the work you're putting in down there.

BASS

I'm okay with it Marshal. I'm not. . .uh. . .I don't like being the focus of attention really.

ANNE

I sensed that just now. Modesty aside. . .you know there's commendations heading your way. The media is eating this up! A Deputy Marshall, stopping a major narcotics ring; based in the South Pole. You're even trending on Twitter!

BASS

I was in the right spot, at the right time is all.

ANNE

FROM A DISTINCE

LLA

Well hey now, I only put three small onions in!

JOYCLYN

Tell me Marlow, because you have me honestly curious. In all the time you were hatching this lite Narcos plan of yours; did you ever stop and think. . .hey, maybe this will bring more than just media praise to my garden?

BASS

I'm hungry, I have a lot of paperwork to get through today and I don't have the time, nor the desire to waste my breath on you.

FOOTSTEPS START, JOYCLYN FADE OUT AS BASS GETS DISTANCE

JOYCLYN

Over a BILLION and a half quid nicked, and you don't think the owner is going to want payback? Well, aren't we thick!

SOUND OF A TRAY BEING PUT ON METAL BAR SLIDERS.

BASS

Afternoon. Um, I'll have the angel hair and red sauce please.

LLA

No problem there Deputy. I'll fish out as many of the onions here that I can.

BASS

[EMBARASSED CHUCKLE] Yeah, I'm sorry about the comment Ms. Alice, it's just. . .she knows how to push by buttons. Your Spaghetti sauce is actually better then my own mother made.

LLA

[SHOCKED GASP]

Well now! Where I come from, that's just about the nicest thing somebody can say about another person's . . . are you fishing for another smooch on the ol cheek there? Cause I have a carpe of a kiss about to swim upstream! Least I can do for the station hero!

BASS

[Chuckle] Raincheck Ms. Alice? Busy day. And uh. . .I'm no hero, okay?

LLA

Oh, pish posh with that kind of talk now! [straining] Here ya go there Deputy. You enjoy your pasta and go tells Zeke and your best gal I says hi!

BASS

Will do, thanks again Ms. Alice.

LLA

Oh, you betcha!

FOOTSTEPS TO THE TABLE

ZEKE

S'up Lawman

KENDRA

Hey you!

BASS

Hey you. Hey Zeke.

CHAIR SLIDES OUT AND BASS SITS

KENDRA

I uh. . .I saw you and Joyclyn exchanging words. What is it this time?

ZEKE

[LOOKING AROUND FOR HER] Oh snap! What I miss?

BASS

[SIGH] She was trying to get me to lose my temper. Trying to deflate the drug intercept accomplishment.

KENDRA

Good luck to her with that! It's the only thing people around here . . .hell, people at all the stations are talking about. Stateside too!

ZEKE

Oh, I get it. She pointing out how you hate the spotlight? How you won't accept any of the PRAISE that you are due! How you go around with that country-boy, aww-shucks bull.shit. . .pardon my language Doc. . and try to give all the praise to others?

[TWO BEAT]

BASS

[ANNOYED] You done?

ZEKE

Yeah, I'm good.

BASS

No. That wasn't what it was about; but glad to hear my best FRIEND has me all figured out cover to cover!

ZEKE

[MOUTH HALF FULL]

Not like you war and peace lawman, you more like mhmmmmm, like a pop-up-book!

KENDRA

That's enough boys! Now, if it wasn't. . .that; what was it then?

Honestly, something I had thought of, but was trying to keep in the back of my head. Retribution. We took a MASSIVE amount of product off the game board. Over a billion in US dollars, internally we're hearing it may get as high as two or even two and a half. That's not a sum you just chalk up to the cost of doing business. No. . the owners are going to want retribution.

ZEKE

Chinese?

BASS

Early intel has Triad written all over it. 14-K Yan, Big Circle or Hunan Gang, or scarry as it sounds it could be ALL of them.

KENDRA

BASS

[SIGH] Thankfully, you can't exactly just jump a direct flight to the pole; don't have any direct family left state-side; so, if they're going to come at me. . .it's not going to be easy.

KENDRA

BASS

TWO BEAT

WOW! The amount of testosterone flying around here is really thick! Guess I should head back to work before. . .you know. . .[manly impression] I start talking about sports, talk about fishing boats or [FAKE SPIT SOUND] how I'm going to go get me some young THANG!

HER CHAIR SLIDES BACK. BASS IMMEDATLEY STANDS

BASS

Oh. Well okay then. See you tonight for dinner?

KENDRA

[STILL IMITATING A GUY] [DEEP SNIFF] You know it BRO! Let's get some brews and then we'll. . .go. . .cruising the strip, or arm wrestle. . .or go to. . .[STRUGGLING TO KEEP IT UP] go to a. . .booby bar and. . .look at. . .boobs. Whoo-Hoo!

BASS

Okay, point made. Love you.

KENDRA [Walking away] You better!

FOOTSTEPS WALKING OFF. BASS SITS BACK DOWN

ZEKE

[MOUTH FULL OF FOOD] Don't. . .know what she all on about! We don't. . .[MUNCH MUNCH] sound like all that!

BASS

[JOINS IN] Nah! So, you watching the game tonight?

ZEKE

You know it! Have to finish working on the timing ignition and then pump some serious iron before I can watch the game!

BASS

We still going hunting this weekend?

ZEKE

Hell yes, but let's stop at the bar afterwards for a few and then hit up that new Boobie bar I just heard about today!

BASS

[HOME IMPROVEMENT GRUNT]

ZEKE

[HOME IMPROVEMENT GRUNT]

TWO CHAIRS SLIDE BACK FROM ACROSS THE GALLEY; THE CROWD GOES SILENT

ZEKE

Easy Biggs boys! We wasn't making fun of you! Respect guys! It's all good.

GRUNTING FROM ACROSS THE GALLEY AS THEY RETAKE THEIR SEATS. GALLEY CROWD VOLUME RETURNS

BASS Guess she wasn't too far off huh?

ZEKE

Probably took it a bit too far. Especially with Dan and Dave holding onto a perfect record. Six weeks into the season and not one fight yet.

BASS

Are they okay? I've seen those two get into it over some simple stuff. Is Goofy a dog or cow was my personal favorite!

ZEKE

[CHUCKLE]

Yeah, that one was a classic! But them being okay? I think so. They still show up for their shifts on time. Get their work squared away. Still watch their cartoons every morning and Hockey reruns at night. Other than not fighting one another every fifteen minutes; they're acting normal.

BASS

Lets. . .let's keep an eye on them for a while. Just, just to make sure.

ZEKE

Sounds good to me, Lawman. I'mma going head back down to the Arches. Get everything set for the next supply shipment we getting day after tomorrow.

CHAIR SLIDES OUT, TRAY PICKED UP

ZEKE

ZEKE

MMMMM, [MOUH FULL} Thanks again Lawman! [CHUCKLE AS HE WALKS OFF]

BASS [CHUCKLES]

BASS' RECORDER: RECORDING STOPPED

ACT III

JOYCLYN'S RECORDER: RECORDING HAS COMMENCED

WE HEAR NEW SOUNDS; NOT EVER RECORDED PREVIOUSLY. THE HUM OF A LAB, BACKGROUND TECHNOLOGY NOISES AND A PULSATING HUM. THERE IS A VOICE OVER THE INTERNAL P.A. SYSTEM READING OFF TELEMETARY DATA.

JEMMA

. . .And nothing we didn't see several times before. Well. . .I mean that the other's saw before with Doctor Rodney. I wasn't on station yet. Obviously!

JOYCLYN

Hand me that please.

JEMMA

Oh! You should wait to put that on until after decontamination!

JOYCLYN

Right. I can't tell you how much I loath this process.

JEMMA

Last thing we want is to have a stray. . .that thing is recording, isn't it?

JOYCLYN

What it's designed to do luv.

JEMMA

We all, I mean. . .the scientists assigned to the project will chat anywhere in the hidden complex and all the way up to this point in decom. . but after this point; any chatting about what goes on inside doesn't happen. Last thing we want is to have news or gossip spread all like. . .oooh! Like a termite colony in a lumberyard! Oh, that would be a bad thing.

WE HEAR THE HUM OF UV DECOM LIGHTS FLICK ON AND REMAINING STEAD FOR TWENTY SECONDS

JOYCLYN

What is it with you and the crawly things?

JEMMA

For a while there, back in university it was a hard choice I had to make. Do I move forward with a doctorate in Particle physics first, or do I pursue my passion of entomology! It's a hard choice for a person to make. [UNEASY] So. . .I hear Doctor Van Zandt's last day here is in two three weeks. When are you; approaching Doctor Jennings to make the offer?

JOYCLYN

Still the old dossier to go through. A few bits and bobs of paperwork and background to consider. [Content chuckle] Can't wait to see Marshmallows face when he finds out that she'll be told EVERYTHING; but can't say anything to him about it!

JEMMA

That's assuming she accepts the invitation to be part of Atlas, of course.

JOYCLYN

Oh. . .I have it on good authority this is an offer that she'll be very interested in pursuing.

JEMMA

[SARCASTICLY]

Well, THAT doesn't sound ominous at all!

WE HEAR THE 'PING' SOUND OF THE DECOMTAMINATION PROCESS FINISHING. SOUND OF CLOTHES BEING PUT BACK ON.

JOYCLYN

Nothing untoward, I assure you. I wouldn't harm a precious hair on that little bit of nummy-nummy Marlow gets to romp with! Just that. . .well let's say outside influences of HER own. . .will be coming into play.

JEMMA

[UNDER HER BREATH] Romp with? And people say I'm creepy!

JOYCLYN

Hrmm, say again luv?

JEMMA

Oh, I said. . wow this hand sanitizer is leaky!

BODY CAMERA GETS AFFIXED TO JOYCLYN'S SHIRT.

JOYCLYN

Alright then. Parkas and boots on. Let's go.

WE HEAR A SIX-DIGIT CODE BEING ENTERED IN AND THEN A CONFIRMATION BEEP. A DOOR SLIDES OPEN AND THE TWO BEGIN WALKING DOWN THE ICE TUNNELS.

JEMMA

Doctor Waynewright wanted to chat with you once the afternoon session was complete. He didn't say what it was about.

JOYCLYN

I'm sure whatever it is, it will be overly pompous and an absolute waste of my time. I'll stop by his office after I'm done with a few errands of my own. I don't have time to deal with his misogyny at the moment.

JEMMA

[SURPRISED]

Misogyny? Hrmm. I've never seen him act any different to me than he does the others. He's pretty consistent in his lack of opinion in everybody.

JOYCLYN

Are you completely daft? He hates women! How he's managed to last this long with that behavior is even more problematic. Oh no! I was clear with . . .leadership at Beauregard-Lowing that I wasn't going to put up with his rubbish or him throwing his toys out the pram.

JEMMA

Maybe it's just I'm too focused on the work as opposed to the social interactions that I don't see it.

JOYCLYN

[PERPLEXED]

You spent almost 5 full days with him between the snow cat and the Canadian future station; and he never once questioned you or your abilities to do your job?

JEMMA

JEMMA

Okay. I'm going to head up to the station. They're serving bread pudding and buttered green beans all day! Can't miss it, it's my favorite.

JOYCLYN

[REPULSED]

Uughhh! Lord help me; They're not served mixed together I trust.

JEMMA

Oh no. I have to do that myself!

JOYCLYN

[DEEP SIGH] Thank you . . .Doctor, I need to stop by Logistics arch. We'll chat later.

WALKING DOWN THE HALL

JEMMA Take care Agent Fowler!

JOYCLYN Gah, and people say I'm creepy!

JOYC'S RECORDER: RECORDING HAS CONCLUDED

ACT IV

FADE IN. BASS' OFFICE. HE'S ON A PHONECALL WITH FIONNA

FIONNA

. ...we haven't seen this this much publicity in. ...well EVER! A lot of attention is still focused on the ATF's office in Houston where the drugs are; but we have just as many local and national reporters here in Honolulu.

BASS

Can't tell you how happy I am being down here then. Chuc. . .Marshal Murphy would no doubt have me front and center doing the interview circuit. No thanks!

FIONNA

You should see the headshot they're using for you on the news. It's from like. . .ten years ago back when you weren't getting gray hairs yet! Suit and tie in front of teg Marshals shield downstairs!

BASS

I remember being told multiple times to go take that picture. Brass always want a formal headshot in the event one of their Marshals gets a huge win so they can flash it on the stage. On to be on an easel next to their casket if things go the other way.

THREE BEAT

FIONNA

Being a bit morbid, aren't we? This is a HUGE deal Bass!

BASS

[EXASERBATED SIGH, FACE IN HANDS] FEE!

FIONNA BASS I know you don't You know I don't Like the spotlight like the spotlight!

FIONNA

I know you don't like the credit being placed where the credit is due.

BASS

Do you know. . .the number of interview requests I'm getting every day in my Marshals dot gov email address? Over one hundred, and it's growing day by day.

FIONNA

Give it time; another week or so there will be some new big event grabbing headlines [CHUCKLE] or more likely the president will do or say something that gets attention shifted to him. In the interim, just. . ride the wave out!

OVERHEAD PA CHIME IN THE BACKGROUND

THOMAS

[ON PA; NERVOUS] Doctor Waynewright, please contact ops ASAP.

CHIME OUT

BASS

What's new on your end?

FIONNA

You know me. Miss workaholic! The job eats up a lot of my free time. Some of my friends and I are talking about a weeklong trip to Seattle. We were thinking Japan originally, but; given the state of international relations all over.

BASS

Good call. Sounds like things are getting really spooky out there.

FIONNA

As with everything else, we'll adjust to the situation at hand as opposed to waiting for it to adjust to us.

BASS

What happened with . . .what-his-name? The guy in field investigations?

FIONNA

Uh-huh! So anytime I ask you about you and Kendra you get all defensive and clam up. . .but you're free to ask me about my love life?

TWO BEAT

BASS

[DEFENSIVE, BROTHERLY FOR SISTER] I see. So, there is a love life to be defensive of now, huh?

TWO BEAT

FIONNA

[PETURBED] You know I hate it when you do that!

BASS

How long?

FIONNA

Oh, I am SOOOOOO not talking to you about this! Like. . .EVER!

BASS

As if I could do anything from down here anyway.

FIONNA [ANNOYED] You intimidated James while you were on assignment in Cincinnati that one time. He stopped responding to any of my calls after that.

BASS

Okay, ONE! I had just been shot in the leg! Two, I was super dopped up on Vicodin in the hospital. Three, there was an open land-line next to the bed. Four, I didn't appreciate the way to spoke to you, and frankly you shouldn't have been either and five. . . . I've only apologized like forty times for that over the last eight years.

FIONNA

He moved out of Hawaii. Last I heard he was living somewhere on the mainland. You going to tell me now what it was you said to him to make him run?

BASS

[SOMEWHAT APOLOGETIC] It's not important, and anyway. . .I don't honestly remember.

TWO BEAT

FIONNA [STERN, FOCUSED, MOM-VOICE] Are you lying to me Bass Marlow?

BASS

[SHEEPISH]

Yeah.

FIONNA

Hence, why I'm not going to talk about Connor. [THREE BEAT] DAMN IT!

BASS

Alight. Now I have a first name. That should be all I need to start.

FIONNA

Bass!

Fee!

TWO BEAT

FIONNA

You need to stop!

BASS

Oh c'mon! You know I'm only. . .like half kidding. It might even shock you to hear that I'm not jumping in to try to solve every problem that Kendra has. I'm accepting that she is a grown up, is able to speak up for herself and I don't stick my foot in unless asked.

TWO BEAT

FIONNA

Shut.the.front.door! Now I **HAVE** to meet Kendra if she managed to unwedge that over-protective of ladies stick up your ass!

SOUNDS OF JOGGING FOOTSTEPS RUNNING PAST BASS' OPEN DOOR

BASS

Alright. Sounds like we may have something stirring down here. Need to go stick my head into operations.

FIONNA

[QUICKLY] Real fast! One last thing!

BASS

What's up?

FIONNA

[NERVOUS]

I uh. [DEEP BREATH] I've hesitated saying, anything givin. . well, everything going on.

BASS

You're making me nervous, Fee!

FIONNA

After; well after they finished clearing out. . .Chuck's office; they found some documents and. . .and a computer file.

BASS

Okay. [TWO BEAT] Anddddddd?

FIONNA

The documents: I'll scan those and include them in the email. They're. . .it's his and Janet's last will and testament. The computer file is on a thumbdrive. I downloaded the file, but its password protected. I could break it in theory, but I'm almost positive it's for you and that you'd already have the password. The file is named. . .send underscore to underscore donkey underscore brains. If um. . .if you think you're up for it. . I send the file down. Looks like an MP4 file, so probably a personal video message.

BASS

[CONFUSED]

Charlie couldn't work a V.C.R; let alone a laptop webcam. [SIGH] Send me what you found. I'll go through it.

FIONNA

You sure you're ready?

BASS

Just send it, okay?

FIONNA

Alright. I'll send it now. You take care of yourself down there. We'll chat soon.

BASS

Bye Fee.

HANGUP SPEAKER. BASS SITS UP FROM HIS DESK AND OPENS HIS OFFICE DOOR. WALKING DOWN THE HALL TO THE OPERATIONS CENTER. WE HEAR THE STANDARD STATION NPISES AND CHATTER INCREASE AS HE APPROACHES.

LARRY

But I honestly can't say I'm surprised, given the. . .unusual warm reaction from last year.

OPS WORKER

Final telemetry confirmed. They're prepping to take off and will be here late this evening.

LARRY

Mister Kelley. Have the new policies from Washington DC been put into effect yet?

THOMAS

Um; well, no sir, not yet anyway. Still another week before they go into full enforcement. For now, we're just supposed to document and record. No other restrictions for now.

LARRY

BASS

[LOW SO AS TO NOT INTERUPT] Mister Kelley? Is there a problem?

LARRY

Oh, I honestly don't really care. Just excited this will be their last visit for a while after the Senate restrictions are in place. Finally, something is going. . .[DOOR SHUTS]

THOMAS

Should. . .Do you want me to head downstairs and get it out from Reno's private stock? I'm happy to do it!

BASS

No Mister Kelley. No. This is something I've been waiting on for a long time now. Too long!

RECORDING STOPPED

ACT VI

FADE IN. WE'RE IN THE LARGE CONFERENCE ROOM. ALL THE DEPARTMENT HEADS AND A FEW OTHER ARE MEETING TO DISCUSS THE UPCOMING TROLL VISITATION.

ZEKE

. ...but I think the main point to take away from my boy Keenan's presentation here; is he talks TOO DAMN MUCH! Condense youngblood! You ain't impressing nobody with fifty-cent words!

A FEW CHUCKLES FROM THE CROWD

ZEKE

Nah, nah. I'm just clown'n with him. Man brings up some really good points. We usually only get three or four trolls at any one time. When they alone and apart from one another, things are only mildly bad.

You get them all together, and there is ANY booze within thirty yards; that when it gets wild up in here! Expect property damage. Anything not secured down will be used as a projectile. Less. . . stuff to break in there. I have their guest berths all set and reinforced and Reno Dave said he'd be happy to host them in the new bar upon their arriving. Glass mugs are stowed away, and his finest plastic ware will be out tonight. Gonna. . .red solo cup it up! [Chuckle]

JOYCLYN

[UNDER HER BREATH]

Bum kisser!

ZEKE

Nice Job Tommy! You sure you got all that covered?

TOMMY

LARRY

You had more pressing business to attend to DEPUTY Marshal? The Norwegian contingent landed five minutes ago and are on their way from Pax station. [HARRRUMP] Honestly!

KENDRA

[LEANS OVER] Hey you! Everything. . . okay?

BASS

Hey you. Nah, everything is BETTER than fine. Just wanted to make a few last-minute checks to ensure we were all ready.

KENDRA

I'm so curious to finally. . .well to have enough courage . . .

BASS

To be comfortable. . .

KENDRA

Better put!. . .To be comfortable to interact with the . . .the trolls. . .I've only ever heard the stories after their visits.

BASS

I must admit, I wasn't sure what I was in for last year when they visited. After all the precautions I saw, all the hesitation and concern from people here on station; I thought it was going to be a disaster.

KENDRA

JA, VI ELSKER DETTE LANDET PLAYS ON THE STATION PA

VOICE ON PA The national anthem, of the Norway people.

LARRY

PIECE OF PAPER BEING UNFLODED. THREE BEAT

LARRY

[SHOCKED, DISBELEIF]

Uh. . . I won! I, I won the Nobel Prize.

THOMAS

[EXCITED] Isn't it WONDERFUL! Let me be the first to shake the hand of the newest Nobel Laureate!

LARRY

I won? Well yes, yes Mister Thomas, Thank you. Thank you indeed but. . .

AIRLOCK DOOR OPENS, ROWDY BUNCH ENTER THE STATION

TROLL I HOW-DEE! ICE SHERIFF BASS!

ISLIN

[WARMLY] Hello again Deputy Marshal!

WE HEAR BASS' BODYCAMERA BEING TAKEN OFF.

BASS Zeke, Hold onto this for me!

RAPID BOOTSTEPS FADING OUT AND THEN THE SOUND OF AGGRESSIVE HORSEPLAY.

LARRY

[DISBELEIF]

I, I won!

KENDRA [SHOCKED] BASS! What are you. . .Zeke! Help him!

ZEKE Nah, he's good. Everything is okay.

KENDRA BUT THEY'RE FIGHTING!

ZEKE

Aww, no. . they're not fighting, Lawman is just thanking them. You know, for saving his life last season.

KENDRA

[SO CONFUSED] Thanking them?

ZEKE He's thanking them, their way!

LARRY

I, won?

OUTRO & CREDITS
