[ANNOYED]

ANGRY FOOTSTEPS LEAVING OPERATIONS

CHERYL-LYNN

Well bless her heart!

RADIO PAGE SOUND

JOYCLYN

[ALMOST GROWLING]

MISTER KELLEY, WHERE ARE YOU?

RADIO SOUND

THOMAS

[ON COMMS]

Morning agent. I'm in the Logistics arch conducting a tally report. Everything alright?

RADIO SOUND

JOYCLYN

[SARCASTIC]

Oh, yes! I'm doing quite brilliant this morning. Was thinking of going for a stroll in the garden later. NO EVERYTHING IS NOT BLOODY ALRIGHT YOU TWIT! WHERE ARE THE DUTY ROSTERS? WHO WAS ON SHIFT IN THE ARCHES LAST NIGHT?

RADIO SOUND

THOMAS

[PANICKED ON COMMS]

The um. . .um. . .oh. . .

RADIO SOUND

ZEKE

[ON COMMS]

Why you giving Tommy the business, Spooky Spice? If you want duty Rosters, you been down here long enough to know to come to me. I'm happy to hand them over.

RADIO SOUND

JOYCLYN

[ANNOYED]

I don't remember asking you anything, spanner-turner!!

RADIO SOUND

ZEKE

[ON COMMS]

[CHUCKLE] Yeah, sounds like you didn't know to really. I'm in the VMF now. Work roster right here. [TAP TAP]. You welcome to it! Gonna let us know what got you all worked up?

FOOTSTEPS CHANGE DIRECTION

JOYCLYN

Something is missing. . .in one of the labs. I want to know who was nearby.

ZEKE

[ON COMMS, CHIDING]

Something goes missing, it's always the help get the blame, huh. Sounds like it the same in England too! Sorry to tell you, but they ain't no labs anywhere down here in the arches. Um. . which lab, was it that has something missing just. . .you know. . .my curiosity?

THREE BEAT. WALKING STOPS. RADIO SOUND

ZEKE

[ON COMMS, CHIDING]

You still there Joyclyn? You forget, or is it one of them. . .

RADIO SOUND

NIC

[ON COMMS]

Yeah, Hi! This is Nic! You all are aware this entire conversation is going out over the operations talk group right? I mean. . .I *am* the entertainment and events coordinator, so if you all really want to make this into a show, or like a Podcast. . .Happy to help. But, here on my talk-group. . . can we NOT. . please?

THREE BEAT. WALKING RESTARTS.

RADIO SOUND

JOYCLYN

[MAD]

KELLEY! Join Bustamante in the VMF arch. I'll be there momentarily.

RADIO SOUND

BASS

[ON COMMS]

So will I. . .

FOOTSTEPS NOW GOING DOWN BEERCAN STEPS AS WE FADE OUT

ACT II

BASS' RECORDER: RECORDING STARTED

FOOTSTEPS ON THE METAL FLOORING. A DOOR OPENS AND WE HEAR THE TYPICAL WORK SOUNDS FROM THE GARAGE.

ZEKE

Hey Lawman, come to watch the show?

BASS

Sorry it took [DEEP BREATH]. . .so long. Ribs still sore.

ZEKE

Ah hell, no need to rush. We got this! How's the healing going?

BASS

Fine, I'm good buddy. Almost back to full speed.

ZEKE

Said the man who tried to bluff with a pair of threes and the WORST tells.

BASS

Cute Zeke. She say what has her worked up yet? Other than something missing?

ZEKE

Naw. Just came in here, grabbed the Luther clipboard and started writing down names of people who had third shift last night.

TOMMY

She seems. . .extra . . .murder-ry this morning. I was busy enough getting supplies for the party tonight, but thought this was. . .

BASS

No harm, no foul Mister Kelley. Why don't you go back to getting all your arrangements in place. I'll cover for you with Joyclyn!

TOMMY

Oh, I appreciate that Deputy Marshal. Zeke, we had the suit cleaned for you and it's all ready to go. Come pick it up in my office when you're ready.

ZEKE

Looking forward to it Tommy!

QUICK FOOTSTEPS HEADING AWAY.

BASS

Hrm. Been a long time since I've seen her this worked up! Typically, she's just being caustic and trying to shoot some part of me. She's really agitated, huh.

ZEKE

She got that vain in her forehead all throbbing and everything. Just won't say what it is got her all steaming.

FOOTSTEPS OVER

JOYCLYN

[STEAMING]

This all of them?

ZEKE

Everybody working on the night crew and what they working on. Yup!

What is this about Joyclyn?

JOYCLYN

Nobody asked for your help Marlow! Buggar off. I'm going to interrogate each one until I find. .

ZEKE BASS

You're doing WHAT now? Whao whoa!

JOYCLYN

You both heard me. One of these simpletons took something that wasn't theirs. I intend to find it!

BASS

One. You're not station law enforcement. Not station security: you have no authority other than the "special science activities" you're guarding. So, can we assume this has something to do with Atlas.

TWO BEAT

JOYCLYN

I remember a time simply mentioning that word. . .got people like Chuck killed!

ZEKE

[WARNING]

Bass!

BASS

I'm alright Zeke. Not going to do anything rash. Two: None of Zeke's people are required to do anything unless they agree to themselves. You can ask to speak to them, but you can't make them.

JOYCLYN

Oh, trust me Marshmellow, I can make them.

Which leads me to Three. Intimidation or assault on any of the station's personal *is* a crime. Unlike you, I have legal jurisdiction and arrest powers. Which leads to four. [THREE BEAT AND GIVE ME BATMAN VOICE] It would be the excuse I've been waiting for.

JOYCLYN

One phone call Marlow, all it would take. To get everything corrected.

BASS

[BATMAN]

And in the process. . .demonstrate your heavily touted and impenetrable security measures, were bypassed in under three months of implementation. . .and by a simpleton? What would that REALLY say. . .about. . .you?

THREE BEAT

ZEKE

There it is! That vain in the forehead again. Damn lawman. . .well played! Shame you can't bring that same skill to poker. Called with a pair of threes; the hell wrong with you?

BASS

Now, given it's the holiday season, and I'm trying my best to be a better person. . .

JOYCLYN

[MAKES FAKE GAG SOUND]

BASS

I'll help you.

THREE BEAT

JOYCLYN

. . .I don't follow.

ZEKE

Whatchu talkin' bout lawman? You get another head injury with the shot to the vest last week?

Serious! Not making a joke here. If something has been taken or misplaced; I'll help. But that means you have to tell me what's missing, so I know what to look for.

THREE BEAT

JOYCLYN

[THROUGH CLINCHED TEETH]

I'll handle this myself.

STOMPING OFF

BASS

Hey buddy, can you make a copy of yesterday's roster for me? I want to follow up to make sure she's civil with your crew if she speaks with them. [PAUSE] Zeke?

ZEKE

[CONFUSED]

Yeah, still with you. I'm just. . .don't know if you're the lawman or a pod-person? Bass Marlow I know... ain't never would have offered to help, her.

BASS

[CHUCKLES]Well, I was only half truthful there. Christmas time seems to put me in a better mood these days, so. . .trying to be more friendly.

ZEKE

Okay. . .what's the other half, not truthful?

BASS

Do the unexpected. She thinks you'll go left; you go right. She thinks you're gonna zig, you. . .

ZEKE

Make horrible barbeque for the party tonight. I get you now!

BASS

Exactly!

ZEKE

Got to say though. . .I like seeing this side of the lawman! Going get you one of them ugly sweaters to wear?

BASS

Let's; not go that far!

[BOTH CHUCKLE]

ZEKE

You get all the gifts you ordered from Reno when you was in McMurdo?

BASS

Got them all, wrapped and ready to be delivered.

ZEKE

You just slip them in Santa's bag lawman. . .I have it on good authority he gonna get it to all the good kids tonight!

BASS

See ya tonight buddy!

FOOTSTEPS OUT

BASS' RECORDER: RECORDING STOPPED.

ACT III

FADE IN

WE'RE IN A CONFERENCE ROOM. THE BACKGROUND NOISE IS DIFFERENT THAN THE STATION. IN THE ATLAS SECURED COMPLEX. THERE IS SOME UNEASY CLEARING OF THROATS AND A FEW "UMS" AND SHUFFELING.

JOYCLYN

[TRYING TO MAINTAIN CALM]

I assure you doctors. I'm MORE than happy to stay here all day and into the night until I'm sure that neither of you had anything to do with a week's worth of tracking telemetry, disappearing.

JOVAK

[UPSET]

Buttttttt; what about the Christmas party tonight? I'm pretty sure, Santa is bringing me the present I was asking for. [UNDER BREATH] Lionel Choo-choo with working smokestack. . .everything.

JOYCLYN

I.Don't.Give. . .two tosses about a party, about holiday cheer, and if I don't get that data back by tonight, that train is going up SOMEBODY'S BUM!

JEMMA

You can't honestly think, one of us would breach the non-disclosure agreement and sneak out. . .

JOYCLYN

There are two possibilities: Doctor. Somebody snuck in or hacked their way in and removed it; or somebody from inside snuck it out!

JEMMA

Two possibilities you've considered. Given the work done in here and in. . .well, I guess reality is subjective to the observer, but there are *countless* possible. . .

JOYCLYN

[ANGRY]

ENOUGH! [DEEP BREATHS, TRYING TO CONTROL HER ANGER]

JOVAK

[MUTTERING]

Yelling. . . .not going to get you results I think you want. Plus, where's Doctor Waynewright? Why isn't he subject to this?

JOYCLYN

Oh, trust me Jovac. Lawrence isn't above my suspicion. None of you are. He's on his way down here now after they fixed the door to operations.

JEMMA

I keep telling them they need to shim it with the low moisture outside and warm air inside.

JOYCLYN

Let's. . . . [DEEP CALMING BREATH] start at the beginning. Doctor Jovac.

JOVAK

Present!

JOYCLYN

You were in main control last night.

JOVAK

Yes, yes indeedee! Seven P.M. until three. . .THREE in the morning. Missed the pancake dinner and not happy about it.

JOYCLYN

You took over from Waynewright.

JOVAK

Correct.

JOYCLYN

Lorenz wasn't around.

JOVAK

Well, not in the lab, anyway!

JOYCLYN

What did the night entail?

JOVAK

Well, the variable window [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. I watched it for the full seventy-two minutes it [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. JOYCLYN

No, not counting me.

JEMMA

JOYCLYN

You what?

JEMMA

How do we know it wasn't you, or actions you caused that led to the weeks' worth of telemetry disappearing?

JOYCLYN

[INDIGNANT]

Are you daft? I was sent down here to safeguard all this!!!

JOVAK

[SING-SONGY]

Doesn't mean you're without suspicion! While I was working [UNDER BREATH] on the railroad. . . All the live long day. . . maybe YOU. . . were in the kitchen with Dinah!

JEMMA

Early folk songs not withstanding Agent Fowler. . .you have to admit that having been inside a secured government facility only four people on the station can access. . .highest statistical probabilities suggest at least a twenty-five percent possibility that you could be the culprit!

JOYCLYN

If I had done it, I wouldn't have said anything about it being missing. I wouldn't be sitting here with you lot! [SIGH] Back to last night.

SOUND OF A DOOR OPENING, CLOSING BEHIND.

LARRY

Alright, I'm here now. The doorframe. . .which was perfectly fine this morning has been repaired and I have been liberated. May I ask what the criticality is that necessities my presence?

JOYCLYN

We've had a security breach in Atlas.

LARRY

[SHOCKED]

What? What happened?

JEMMA

LARRY

JOVAC

ACT IV

BASS

JULIA

BASS

[REALIZATION]

JULIA

As hard as it is for me to believe, since I returned, they haven't had so much as a cross word between the two of them. They're up to something, I know it!

BASS

Well, good luck with everything. If you'll excuse me?

FOOTSTEPS AWAY

BASS

KENDRA

FRED AND KATHERINE WALKING BY

DOCTOR TIMMS

The newest Danielle Steel book! Oh, thank you Fredrick!

FRED

I remember how much you said you liked reading the old broads works. Lord knows you talk enough about her!

DOCTOR TIMMS

Oh we'll deal with that comment when we're back home later on. . .

TAPPING ON THE MICROPHONE

LARRY

Good evening, everybody. Good. . .can you PLEASE turn off the music Mx. Webster?

MUSIC CUTS OUT

LARRY

Lovely. [BREATH] I apologize for my tardiness this . . .festive evening. I was, very avoidably delayed with, not very pressing work. However, that is now over with [UNDER BREATH] thankfully.

Ah yes. . . this thing. . . . again. [CLEAR THROAT]. My-my! How lovely it is to see all your cheery faces this evening as we come together to celebrate. . .

[TO HIMSELF] everything was crossed out? Um. .
to honor this multi-cultural, dignified
celebration of cross-beliefs and ensuring. .
[FRUSTRATED] Ms. June; were you drinking when you
edited this. I can't read this next part. .

JULIA

[LOUDLY FROM BACK OF THE ROOM]

Ensuring traditions are held without inconveniencing others who don't agree with the patriarchy on. . .why are you all looking at me?

CHERYL-LYNN

[FROM DISTANCE]

Don't be throwing no shade my way Doctor Grumpy-Pants! I know better!

CROWD GROANS

LARRY

Guess I'll just improvise this year, won't I? Okay then.

Ah! I have it.

"Oh! But he was a tight-fisted hand at the grindstone, Scrooge! a squeezing, wrenching, grasping, scraping, clutching, covetous, old sinner! Hard and sharp as flint, from which no steel had ever struck out generous fire; secret, and self-contained, and solitary as an oyster. The cold within him froze his old features, nipped his pointed nose, shriveled his cheek, stiffened his gait; made his eyes red, his thin lips blue; and spoke out shrewdly in his grating voice. A frosty rime was on his head, and on his eyebrows, and his wiry chin. He carried his own low temperature always about with him; he iced his office in the dogdays; and didn't thaw it one degree at Christmas."

APPLAUSE AS A DOOR FLYS OPEN

SANTA-ZEKE

But you all can call me Santa! Ho-Ho-HO ya'll. I do love me this time of season! Ho-Ho-Ho. [LAUGH A SANTA LAUGH] Hey KEENAN! Maybe old saint Nick gift wrapped you some common sense this year huh?

MARRY CHRISTMAS. . . AND ALL THEM OTHER THINGS TOO! HO-HO HO!

Let's see what I have here. Where is little Karl? Doctor Jovac?

JOVAC

Did you get my letter?

SANTA-ZEKE

HO-HO-HO! Here you go Karl, I got it!

JOVAC

Oh. . .hot diggity dog! My Lionel. OH, HAPPY DAY EVERYBODY!

BASS

I don't think he gets this happy and excited about ANYTHING as he does playing Santa each year.

SANTA-ZEKE

[FROM A DISTANCE]

Where's Patrick? Special delivery all the way from your Cousin Jimmy's Store in Wisconsin!

BEELINE SPRINT TO THE STAGE

PATRICK

Aw man Cousin Jimmy ALWAYS comes through! Marry Kush-mas! Thanks Santa.

SANTA-ZEKE

Yeah, Santa gonna pretend he didn't hear none of that.

KENDRA

Bass. We um. . .well we all got together and we. . .we're in the process of getting something for you but will need another week or so.

BASS

Oh, I really wish you guys wouldn't go to all that trouble for me!!

KENDRA

Hush you! I don't think you really understand just how much you mean, not just to me. . .but to all of us! You've not only made a difference here, and in yourself. . .but to all of us!

BASS

Okay, okay. . .that's enough. I get it.

KENDRA

Really Bass. I mean it. We all mean it!

BASS

[UNCOMFORTABLE]

I understand Kendra. I guess this is a good enough time to give you your present. Picked it up in McMurdo while I was there.

KENDRA

And you're sure you're alright after. . .being shot? I mean you were only off work for one-week for recovery!

BASS

The vest took the brunt of it. A few bruised ribs. It's not the first time I've been shot in my career.

UNWRAPPING GIFT

KENDRA

Not sure if that is supposed to comfort me or make my anxiety worse! [TWO BEAT] Bass! This is beautiful. Is it.

CLICK OF A LOCKET OPENING

BASS

It's a locket, yes. I know you have a skin allergy to gold, so I picked one in silver. Inside is a picture of me, and then a photo of us from last New Year's I had shrunk.

KENDRA

This is so sweet. Help me put it on?

Absolutely!

KENDRA

Thank you so much sweetie. Merry Christmas

BASS

Merry Christmas.

HEAVY FOOTSTEPS APPROACH.

SANTA-ZEKE

Ho-Ho-Ho ya'll. I'm guessing that. . . Doc Jennings told you the team gift is a bit delayed.

KENDRA

Ooh! I want to go show Ms. June my locket! Be right back.

HEALS LEAVING

BASS

Yes, she did and it's alright. I just wish you all wouldn't go to such efforts.

SANTA-ZEKE

That's why they call it, the season of giving lawman. Plus, I think. . .I know once you see it you're going to love it.

BASS

I'm sure I will. Did you open my gift yet?

SANTA-ZEKE

Hrmm, oh no not yet. Um, Santa has been busy, handing out gifts, making the rounds. Keeping on schedule. . .

Look, need to get back on my rounds but. . .just wanted to say, Santa may not have a gift in this here bag for you Bass, but if'n I'm honest. You have probably the best present waiting to be opened in your office.

BASS

Huh?

SANTA-ZEKE

The thumb drive from your old Boss. From Chuck. Just sitting there cause I'm sure you being all stubborn and still holding onto some feelings about what happened. Just. . .Damn Lawman, you know what people would give to get one more message from they folks that passed on? Last thing. . .very last thing you want to do is to let that thing go unheard for too long.

Consider it. . . A special Christmas delivery.

[TWO BEAT]

SANTA-ZEKE

Okay, and with that. . .[GRUNT PICKING UP GIFT BAG] Santa got a few more presents and stops to make. Um. Hey, TOMMY?

THOMAS

Hi Santa! Oh, I see you found the deputy Marshal after all!

SANTA-ZEKE

Yeah! Hey. . .Santa needs to be done in the LO Arch in a few minutes. Gift some joy to the two cats that had to man the monitors for the fuel Arches. Have the last president to Waynewright to give. You do me a solid and deliver it?

THOMAS

No problem Santa. Guess that makes me. . . one of Santa's elves! [CHUCKLE]

SANTA-ZEKE

[HURRIED]

Yeah, I guess it do. Okay. Thanks Tommy. See you in a few Lawman!

[FOUR BEAT]

BASS

Mister Todd! Good to see you this evening!

IT CHRIS

Hi, Deputy Marshal. How's the party going.

It's, as festive as it is normally. You just missed Doctor Waynewright's address.

IT CHRIS

No, no I heard it. Was just. . .toward the back of the room.

BASS

Ah! I understand, believe me. . . I get it. It does get better.

IT CHRIS

I know I know, and I didn't mean to bring the mood down.

BASS

You didn't! I promise you Mister Todd. I'm happy to have you hear talking with me. Happy that you came out tonight.

CHRIS

By the way, thank you for your present! The second season boxed set of the Mandalorian! I look forward to watching it.

BASS

I figured you wouldn't have had it yet and am happy to be able to get it for you.

LARRY

Oh, the um. Final gift of the year. Is to me of course. After the last. . year's present. . .

UNWRAPPING

LARRY

[UNAMUSED]

A bag of keyboard keys. All the letter "W".

LAUGHS FROM THE CROWD.

HEALS RETURN TO THE TWO GENTS TALKING.

KENDRA

Honey! Seriously? Do you always have to antagonize him?

BASS

I honestly have no idea WHAT you mean.

KENDRA

Uh -huh. Are you lying?

BASS

Oh absolutely, one hundred percent!

KENDRA

Hi Chris! It's great to see you tonight.

IT CHRIS

You too, Doctor. You too!

LARRY

Amusing gift DEPUTY marshal. I trust this was from you?

BASS

I can't say it is Doctor. I'm not one for practical jokes and joking now.

LARRY

Please don't mistake my question for interest DEPUTY Marshal, I don't truly care! No, I'm here to deliver a present of my own. This. . .parcel was left accidently on my desk. Must have been accidently placed there. It's for you Mister Todd.

BASS

For me?

LARRY

Well unless there is another. . .individual on this station named Christopher Todd. [SIGH] Some people.

IT CHRIS

Huh. Well. . .thank you Doctor.

LARRY

Do not thank me! I have nothing to do with that item. Simply the messenger I assure you!

UNWRAPPING

IT CHRIS

It's one of the stations' iPad minis. It's. . .huh, looks like it has some sort of. . .data on it.

KENDRA

That's...that looks like telemetry data. It's been collected over, what looks like ten days. It's unusual because it's...those are sub harmonic pulses picked up on...whatever sensors were used in this experiment.

The Pulses are. . .groups of two, then Three. Five. Sev. . .prime numbers! Each group being picked up on an increasingly narrow band. There's a large data burst after each time the group of seven is recorded.

LARRY

That. . .that was Em! That was Emery! According to this, it was recorded a week ago. He's Alive! My brave little hobbit is still alive! This. . .this is the best Christmas gift ever! Thank you so much Doctor Wayn. . .

LARRY

Do not THANK me! I'm simply the postal carrier here. I have no idea where that telemetry data come from and WON'T vouch for its authenticity!

Now, I WONT wish you a happy holidays Christopher. I WON'T thank you for the sacrifice Mister Waters made saving our lives. I WON'T stay here for, fellowship or merriment. I'll simply leave you with. . .you may all go now!

OUTRO AND CREDITS

DIGITAL RECORDER BEEP

TYPING OF KEYS. SLOWLY. THERE IS A DEEP BREATH, ALMOST AS IF BRACING ONESELF FOR WHAT IS TO COME. WE HEAR A SINGLE KB KEY BEING PUSHED.

CHUCK

. . .can't just make these dagum things easier to operate! Okay. . think we got 'er workin'. [CLEARS THROAT]

Bass. Don't want to get all dramatic and Hollywood on you, but. . .if your listening to me right now, then that means somebody REALLY shit

the bed! Need to set this thing as my ace up the sleeve. Insurance policy I guess you'd say.

When I was in Washington D.C. last week, it was only supposed to be for routine budget reviews and internal Justice Department paperwork. All the fun stuff we Marshals get to do.

Around the second day I was there, I was approached by an individual who said they had information about the pole. About the projects at your research station. About...well they just kept saying "The Ice."

Look over the files I've attached. Bass. . no seriously. . .Bass, listen to me. Hear what I have to say. Get the job done. Then get out.

Retire. You find that pretty little doctor and go make babies. Live. Be happy!

Okay. Gonna go throw up from all that emotion and then get gussied up for Janet. Chuck Goodwin. U.S. Marshal. February 4, 2022.
