New builds aren't the only thing we do, although we're doing that too. This past month, we completed work on eight Rock the Block projects. But first we started work on an A Brush With Kindness that was long overdue. Diane's home in River Falls was due to be repaired in 2018. So we got things back on track and know that the snow won't find a way in this winter. (left corner photo)







Speaking of drafts, Andersen Windows & Doors is helping Pearl by replacing her 1930's era windows. It's part of our <u>Aging in Place</u> program. That means no need for plastic wrap to help Pearl stay warm this year. (bottom right photo)








## **Welcoming Alex Richert**

# See you summer....

We said goodbye to summer with a BANG! August saw the completion of construction at 1135 Rich River Way in New Richmond. Over the 9-month build period, a total of 314 volunteers put in 4,266 hours and a whole lot of love to build the Koskie home. Just a few of the many AMAZING local organizations that volunteered their time and talent to this home include: Krumm Exteriors, Valley Companies, First Presbyterian Church of Hudson, Sourcing Solutions/River Ridge Homes, Thrivent, RCU, and First State Bank and Trust.

Once that home was wrapped up, we moved right into our next project:
Rock the Block - Elevate Ellsworth!
From September 29 through

October 1, we had 87 volunteers spend almost 400 hours helping to revitalize and uplift multiple homes around Ellsworth,undertaking exterior work that included yard clean up, siding repair, porch repair, and painting. Although the weather threw us a curveball in the form of lots of rain, the enthusiasm our volunteers had for helping the community wasn't dampened at all!

Organizations that deserve a special shout-out for their volunteer involvement include Andersen Windows & Doors, Kraus-Anderson, WESTconsin Credit Union, Our Savior's Lutheran Church of Beldenville, the Ellsworth High School Dance Team, and the Ellsworth High School FFA.
