



# **About St. Croix Valley Habitat for Humanity (SCVHFH)**

St. Croix Habitat for Humanity was founded as an affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International in 1996 by a group of caring and motivated individuals in River Falls, WI. Since then, we have helped change over 70 families' lives through home ownership. In 2014, we completed the first neighborhood-scale project of its kind to combine cutting edge and energy efficient technology, durable building materials, and renewable energy generation. Today we are building in New Richmond for a mutli-generational family who are excited for their first home. And we continue working with families on financial planning and budgeting to move our homeowners toward establishing generational wealth.

### **Vision**

We envision communities where families plant their roots, know their neighbors, and grow together. With a focus on fiscal responsibility, we work to serve more parents, grandparents, guardians, and most importantly – children, to construct quality homes that are sold to families through low to no-interest loans. Homebuyers complete 250 to 500 sweat-equity hours and other requirements, partner with SCVHFH to pay for their homes, property taxes and all upkeep, and maintain current payments on properties.

# **How We Change Lives**

SCVHFH provides home construction, home recycles, and home repair. We work with families who commit financially and invest their time and energy into the home to build affordable, sustainable, and quality homes which leads to life changing results.

- SCVHFH has helped over 70 families throughout Pierce & St. Croix Counties obtain homes since 1996.
- A Brush with Kindness Program supports low-income families and individuals with exterior home
- repairs.
- The Aging in Place Program helps older, low-income homeowners safely stay in the homes they own and love.

The ReStore is our nonprofit home-improvement store that offers a variety of high-quality items to customers at a fraction of a cost while also diverting reusable household items and building materials



### **New Richmond Build**

St. Croix Valley Habitat for Humanity (SCVHFH) works alongside families to break the cycle of poverty and increase access to affordable housing. In 2022, St. Croix Valley Habitat for Humanity is building a home for the Patraw Family in New Richmond that will house three generations under the roof we help them raise. This 5 bedroom, 2 bathroom home will include solar panels to help the Patraws make their home even more affordable and will provide the space, comfort, and security for the whole family to thrive.

We will host our ceremonial groundbreaking in May 2022 and continue the build over the summer. We anticipate about 250 volunteers, including our sponsors, donating more than about 3,500 hours of time alongside the Patraw Family to build their home. Once the build is complete, we will host a dedication ceremony to welcome the Patraws into their new home, celebrate all we have accomplished together, and toast to the family's future.

The opportunity to own a home can put lower-income families on the path to building wealth. Your sponsorship support will ensure our team has the materials and resources needed to provide the Patraw Family with a safe and comfortable place to call home in 2022.

### **Rock the Block**

Our Rock the Block event will take place in late September. This week-long neighborhood revitalization effort brings together residents, municipalities, and community partners to complete exterior home repairs and refresh a neighborhood for low-income homeowners. Each day includes a menu of activities from deconstruction to landscaping and gives our volunteers and sponsors the opportunity to lend a helping hand in their community.

Rock the Block is an opportunity for business leaders like you to join socially engaged community leaders to improve a local neighborhood. Sponsorship support allows us to purchase the necessary building materials and important tools and supplies for these community repairs, and to ensure our team of dedicated volunteers stay well-hydrated and fed as they work. 
