9:00 AM - Orientation & Sign In

- Waivers collected
- Sign in
- Explanation of tasks for the day & safety discussion

9:30 AM - Start Building!

12:00 PM - Lunch Break

- Unless otherwise specified, lunch and snacks are not provided - don't forget to bring something!

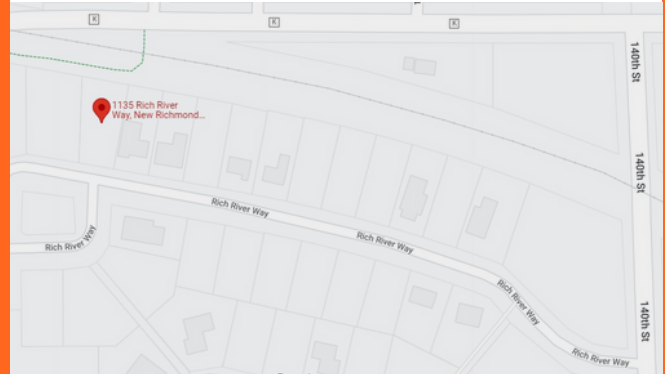
3:00 PM - Clean Up
