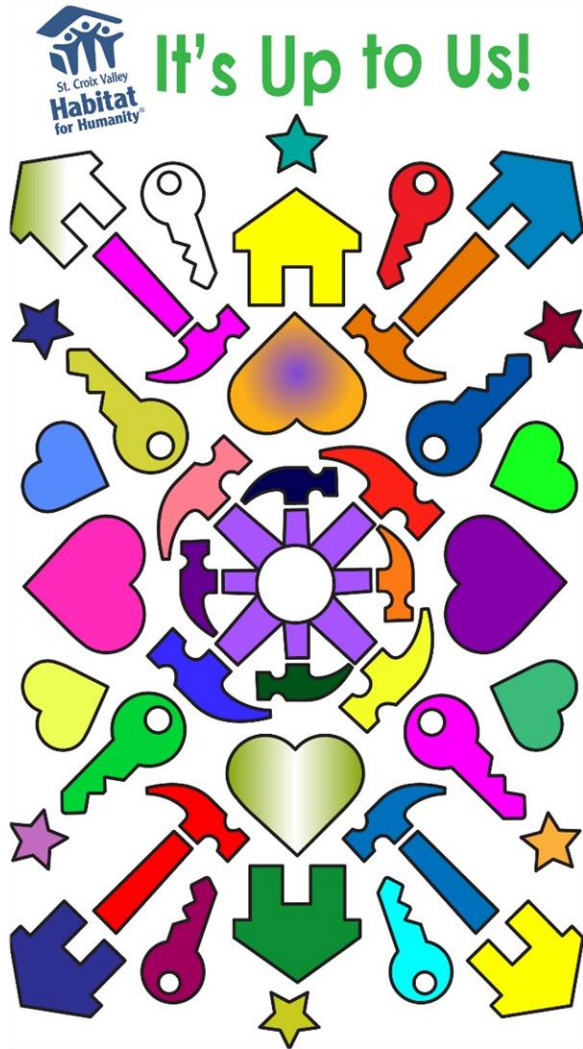


ST. CROIX VALLEY HABITAT FOR HUMANITY SUMMER COLORING CONTEST
