Dear Parade Participant:

Westfest 2018 is here!!! I have attached, to this email, a link to the parade lineup and map. In addition to emailing the Map and Lineup, you can locate these documents at Westfest.com. Please find your number on the parade lineup and proceed to the block that corresponds with that number. Please also note the parade route and dispersal points. **MARCHERS ONLY**, turn left at Spruce Street. Floats and other vehicles continue straight and turn right at Tokio Road. There will be no floats allowed to enter the Westfest grounds.

The map is for lineup purposes only. It may not actually be the way you precede in the parade. Your intersection worker will tell you when it is your turn to go. Please respect the neighborhood. **DO NOT** leave any trash on the street or in someone's yard. These people have been extremely cooperative.

REMEMBER: Floats should be in place and manned by 8:30 a.m. in order to be judged. **Judging will begin at 8:45 a.m.** The floats that are to be judged will line up together within two blocks but will not proceed with the parade until you are instructed. Participants not being judged should be in place at 9:15 a.m. All other vehicles should be in line by 9:30 a.m. **We will have a quick meeting at 9:40 by the West Fire Station. All Drivers Are to Attend.** As soon as the meeting has concluded, please go directly to your entry and be ready to start. The parade will begin promptly at 10:00 a.m.

IMPORTANT: The Board of Directors and the City of West will not allow consumption of alcoholic beverages during the parade. Also, no participant will be allowed to throw items from their vehicles or use any type of water device such as water blasters. If you wish to give candy, please hand it to the children rather than throwing it. No eighteen-wheel trucks, or horses are allowed in parade. Any off-road Vehicles will need to be removed from the parade route immediately upon completion of the parade. We will not allow inappropriate behavior, comments, and/or attire. Will not allow tractor/trailer combination to exceed 30 feet. Will not allow gaps over 30 feet between entries during parade-Please maintain proper distance. During the route, no one may get on or off the float.
