



Westfest Campground Rules and Policies

Emergencies: CALL 911

RV Park Coordinator: Phone is only answered on Friday of festival. TEXT ONLY SATURDAY & SUNDAY. Include your name and site# with question to 254-826-6360

Parking: Choice of: (1) Car permit, OR (1) Golf cart / UTV permit

Each campsite will receive one parking decal that will allow you to park one vehicle at the designated parking area. PLEASE NOTE: Parking decals must be attached to the inside of your windshield to be valid. Holding the decal in your hand and showing it to the parking attendant will not be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS. Vehicles without a parking decal will be towed at owner's expense and/or subject to other action deemed necessary by Westfest security. ALL parking permits are also ALLOWED to park inside the Westfest Parking lot for your convenience. Entrance is located on Cemetery road.

The option to purchase additional parking permits will be available at check-in for \$30. Limit one extra per site.

Main Street Campground only:

NO vehicles will be allowed to drive in the campground after 4:30pm on

Friday until Monday at 6am for safety reasons.

Early Arrivals:

We encourage campers to arrive up to 1 week early if they choose at no charge. This reduces congestion and traffic leading up to Friday before Labor Day weekend. Electric will be turned on at your site when you arrive.

Note: You may turn on your **REFRIGERATOR ONLY** PRIOR TO FRIDAY.

If you wish to run the Air Conditioner prior to Friday, a \$20 per day fee must be added on to the reservation. **Any sites found running their A/C prior to Friday will be disconnected if the fee has not been paid.**

Golf Carts / UTV'S:

Golf carts and registered UTV's are allowed within all campgrounds with permit attached to cart.

All carts & UTV'S must abide by the [City of West golf cart & UTV ordinance \(click here for link\)](#). This includes having a valid DPS/County issued license plate and valid proof of insurance.

Site Assignment and length:

When booking, you must provide the exact length and type of camper you are bringing. Some of our sites have LIMITED SPACE and will not accommodate all lengths of campers. Your belongings must fit within the marked boundaries of your site. **If your camper does not fit upon arrival your reservation may be forfeited.**

Power Outages & Other Maintenance Issues:

If you experience power outage or have maintenance issues, please contact the Westfest office at 254-826-5058 during festival hours. For after-hours emergencies **PLEASE TEXT** the Westfest RV Coordinator at 254-826-6360.

Westfest Dump Stations - On the Westfest Grounds:

Westfest RV dump station will be available Monday as you exit the campground. One dump station is located on 9th Street (next to Main Street Campground) and the other is located at the Padgett Street entrance of the Regan Street Campground.

Quiet Time: Report quiet time violations to West Police Dept 254-826-5311

Quiet time is 1 a.m. – 9 a.m. Please respect others in the campground.

Adult Supervision: Minimum age to book a site is 21.

Minors are not allowed to occupy ANY campsite without the responsible booking party over the age of 21 present at all times. For persons occupying the site between the ages of 18-21, **the supervising parent must be present within the Festival Grounds at all times.** Any site found with an unsupervised minor may be asked to leave by Westfest Security and forfeit their reservation.

Disruptive guests:

If Westfest Security and/or West P.D. are called on upon your site, you may be asked to leave and you will lose your rights to return back in future years.

Trash:

Please pickup all trash and dispose of it in nearby campground dumpsters. If your site is left in an un-desirable condition, you will not be allowed back in the future years.

Westfest Weekend cancellation Policy:

Cancellations before July 31st will receive a full refund minus a \$50 cancellation fee and NO refunds beginning August 1st. Absolutely **NO SUBLETTING** your site! If you are unable to make it to the grounds, you can transfer your reservation into someone else's name. The first transfer will be complimentary however any transfer after that will be subject to a \$20 administration fee. The person listed on the reservation must be the person to check in and an occupant onsite.

Pet Policy:

No more than two dogs per site allowed. Per city ordinance, all pets must be on a leash at all times. Please note that Westfest does not allow any pets on the festival grounds. No aggressive breeds or dogs over 40 pounds.

Open Flame Policy:

No open flame of any kind allowed at the campgrounds. This includes campfires, fire pits, and/or BBQ pits on Westfest property by order of the Fire Marshal, City of West, TX

Westfest reserves the right to refuse, deny and/or cancel any reservation at any time.
