Arizona where they can stay with me and have their room/board covered. One of our new sponsors, **Denise Hansen**, has been kind enough to arrange a meeting with a friend who has gone through the process of bringing a student here to study. After receiving her degree, this student now lives and works in Nairobi, supporting herself and her extended family. I hope to learn how the process works and possibly recruit the young lady in Nairobi to help our kids as well.

The remainder of our other students are doing well and thrilled to be returning to their classrooms; photos and letters to come during their next break in April.

As most of you know, ACF is committed to transforming the lives of Maasai children through education and 100% of your donations go toward this endeavor. Empowering Our Students

In todays world, computer skills are integral to all areas of study and work. Computer literacy is difficult for our students as they lack electricity and internet in their homes and obviously do not have laptops. The primary and secondary schools provide very limited access to computers and do not allow internet use. It's not until University that programs are offered and by that time, our students are far behind the curve.



To address this issue, ACF recently invested in a new program as a trial for two of our older students, Rose and Charity.

The Technology Empowerment Program is designed to teach students basic IT skills including Excel, Word, PowerPoint, Adobe Acrobat, Google Search and more. The two month course is offered at a private institution in Loitokitok, a city not too far from Amboseli Nat'l Park and our villages.

Both Rose (pictured above right) and Charity excelled in this program; finishing in position #1 and #3 respectively in a class of 28.

Going forward we hope to provide this for all of our students before they make the transition to post-secondary school.

Amboseli Children's Fund is committed to transforming the lives of Maasai children living in extreme need in the remote area of Amboseli, Kenya.

Government assistance does not exist for these people. Without our help, they have little hope of breaking free of this cycle of poverty. Education has been proven to be the most single, most effective means of change and your sponsorship will give these children the ability and confidence to set a new course for their future.


Benson Sinkoi - 6 years
