

- and how our contact has made them feel less alone. "What a legacy your beautiful boy has left" said one mum, while another added: "Oh my goodness, I cannot tell you how much this will help."

And it's not just grants! We've given out over 230 Hospital Survival Bags and are at 119 – and counting – with our hugely popular National Trust Family Memberships. We couldn't do it without all of you.

Nicky and Ben were honoured to be invited to the Houses of Parliament by Ceri and Frances, the founders of children's charity, It's Never You.

These incredible parents are campaigning to introduce Hugh's Law, named after their heroic son who lost his life to cancer, aged 6.

MPs attended the meeting, and learned about the difficulties faced by parents when their child is given a shattering diagnosis.

Hugh's Law will implement government financial assistance for families from day one,



helping ensure that jobs and homes are safe. The average treatment time for child cancer is three years, putting families under a massive strain.



Hugh's Law is fair, it is right, and it is just. All of us at Finley's Touch fully support it and hope that it gets the backing it deserves.
