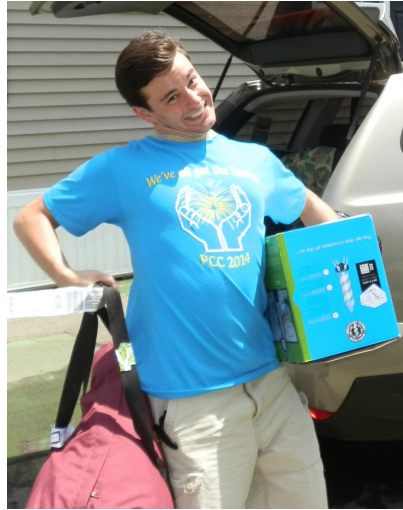

THINGS NOT TO BRING TO PCC

Due to PCC and Stonehill College rules, the **following items are prohibited** from PCC:

TV sets, refrigerators, plug-in coolers, air conditioners, DVD players or portable DVD players, personal gaming devices, microwaves, laptops or computers (this includes Chromebooks, IPADS and macbooks), and other communication devices are not permitted, such as smart watches.

Cell phones are allowed only under the conditions stated under the cell phone policy.
