



PRODIGY ARCHERY RANGE RULES AND WAIVER

1. It is the responsibility of each archer to comply with safety rules and demonstrate common courtesy.
2. All archers must sign in with valid ID and sign out when leaving everytime. You must read and understand Canadian Archery association range rules, archers ethics and sign Prodigy Archery's waiver stating you will not hold Prodigy Archery or owners to any legal responsibilities when using or entering the range boundaries including but not limited to: parking area, spectator area, range, office and or shooting areas. Use at your own risk.
3. To enter the shooting area alone, you must be 18 years of age or older and have a valid waiver On file. If you are under the age of 18, you must be accompanied by a parent or guardian with ID who can sign and read the legal responsibility waiver for you. If you are 16 years of age or older once your parent or guardian has signed your waiver, you can then come to the range unaccompanied with valid ID. Waivers will be valid for six months.
4. You must make sure all of your equipment is in safe working condition. Inspect arrows upon retrieval (nocks, vanes, shafts and points)
5. The gate must be closed and latched when entering and exiting the shooting area at all times.
6. No broadheads are allowed on the range unless you are shooting at a personally owned target brought to the range for that purpose placed in the crossbow lane only by appointment.
7. Absolutely no Firearms allowed on the range. Crossbows are allowed and only to be used in the crossbow lane.
8. If more than one archer is shooting on the range, one of the archers must be designated to call " All Clear " when it is safe to cross the shooting line and " Clear To Shoot " when it is safe to do so. Whistles are available at the office and must be signed in and out.
9. Archers will not cross the shooting line until shooting has ceased and "All Clear" has been called or signal to do so.
10. Never nock an arrow until it is safe to shoot.

11. Shooting is only allowed from designated shooting positions. Extending the distance past the designated shooting position is not allowed.
12. When retrieving arrows; ensure that:
 - A. “ All Clear “ has been called.
 - B. All bows are behind waiting line.
 - C. Your shooting position pylon is placed six feet in front of the shooting line in your lane.
 - D. Do not stray from your target lane.
13. Do not litter. If you put up your own paper or tape targets, take them down when you leave and place them in provided trash bins. Place cans or bottles in recycle bins provided.
14. Smoking is not permitted outside of the designated smoking area. Cigarette butts must be disposed of and approved receptacle provided. Smoking is not permitted on the range, the spectators area or washrooms area.
15. No alcohol or drugs allowed on property, if you appear to be under the influence of either, entry will be denied.
16. Failure to comply with any of these range rules could result in cancellation of your range access for up to two years and you will be asked to leave the facility immediately.
17. Have fun and be kind. Safety is everything.
