- > Budgets didn't change for inspectors at the landing. Funds go for a specific treatment. If we want more than 7k we need a lake inspection.

- > Sucker Creek We will not receive any grant money for feasibility study or sediment removal. Can we do something without a grant probably not because it is too expensive. We need to communicate this to the residents. Robin will type something up to send out.
- ➤ Water Resting Results We should test the water before it goes in the culvert by the Renner's house. We should test what water is going to Stella. Discussed doing more testing next year. In 2019 we spent money on a culvert which slowed down the flow to our lake. We

- would need Huhns to approve access to their land for a sediment pond and we would need to maintain it. Someone is going to talk to Gary Huhn about the land.
- ➤ Nesting Boxes Steve reached out to someone about the Lake Sylvia newsletter but received no response. He called the DNR office and Tanner Stevens said we have a perfect loon habitat so he doesn't feel we should do nesting boxes for the loons.

New Business

- Registering with Secretary of State Barry will register our Lake Association with the Secretary of State which can be used as a donation for tax purposes.

- > DNR Boat Landing Update The land goes into Meeker County Park. There are going to be 2 entrances to the boat landing but they do not have a time frame as to when they are going to do this. DNR doesn't need a permit to the project, The AIS money allocated for boat inspections is based on the number of parking spaces at the landing, and it sounds like that number will be reduced. There is a time frame set on the project.
