TREASURER'S REPORT

Not much happening at this time; bills were paid for the winter events, website and Insurance. Current Balance \$56,368. Motion to approve Dave, S/Steve; motion carried.

Barry has applied for grants for Curly leaf Pondweed and Milfoil Treatment if needed this year. To date we have been awarded a \$3,500 grant of the \$6,500 requested for Milfoil treatment if necessary. There is a second round of grants being awarded, he will apply again for these grants with an emphasis on the Curly Leaf Pondweed treatment. We should hear in the next few weeks if we will be awarded any of the second round of grants. These dollar-for-dollar grants.

We did pay for treatment of Curly Leaf Pond Weed in 2025 if any of the same area's need to be treated again this year, there is a 3-year guarantee of the treatment.
