From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Hard to believe, but we are now in February, which means we are now half-way through winter! February also signifies that Lent is quickly approaching, which begins on Wednesday, February 14th. In next weekend's column, I will review the various Lenten regulations for Catholics. In the meantime, many people have been inquiring whether or not a dispensation will granted from fasting and abstaining from meat on Ash Wednesday, since it falls on Saint Valentine's Day this year. The short answer is no, Bishop Tobin has not granted it. Unlike dispensations that are made when St. Patrick's and St. Joseph's Feasts fall on Friday's in Lent, Ash Wednesday marks the solemn beginning of the Lenten season and has a particular sacred meaning (much akin to Good Friday). This takes precedence over the secularized traditions of Valentine's Day. Keep in mind, there is no prohibition from celebrating Valentine's Day one day before or after the 14th!

This Sunday is a "secular feast day" for many, Super Bowl Sunday. Many of us are excited about watching the New England Patriots playing later today in the Super Bowl. Although I am fan of the Patriots and sports in general, here is the temptation in our culture to elevate these events to something more important than they really are! Sadly, sports have become a religion for many. It begs the question: If we, as a society, possessed the same enthusiasm for the things pertaining to God, wouldn't the world be a better place?

Yes, I do hope the Patriots are victorious, but the greatest victory in all of human history was won for us by Christ 2,000 years ago! We partake and share in this victory through the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Yes indeed, every Sunday is a "Super Sunday!"


