## From the Pastor



### Dear Parishioners,

It seems as if we literally just put away our Christmas decorations, but here we are! The holy season of Lent begins this Wednesday, February 14th. For the next 40 days, Catholics the world over prepare spiritually for the celebration of Easter. Traditionally, Lent is a time dedicated to prayer, fasting and almsgiving. These penitential practices help us focus more attentively on the Lord and assist in remedying personal sin. With that being said, now is a good time to review the Church's Lenten requirements.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are universal days of fast & abstinence, which means that Catholics are to have only one full meal on each of those days, and the other two should be light meals. We also need to abstain from eating meat on those two days. This includes all types of animal flesh except for fish. All of the Fridays during Lent are also days of abstinence from meat. Dispensations from the fast are granted to those over the age of 65 and to those who cannot observe the fast due to health reasons.

\*\*Please note: No dispensation is granted for Valentine's Day, unless for health reasons.\*\*

How can you make this Lent 2018 more spiritually meaningful? Perhaps attend daily Mass or encounter the Lord's great mercy by receiving the Sacrament of Penance? A Lenten Penance Service will be offered on March 12th and regular confessions are scheduled Saturday afternoons from 3:30-4:15 PM. We will be offering the Stations of the Cross on Monday evenings at 6:00 PM. Please pay close attention to the bulletin for the location schedule. Every Friday during Lent, all are welcome to attend the Lenten Fish & Chips at St. Theresa's Hall from Noon- 7 PM.

Don't miss the opportunity to enter more deeply into this Lenten Season. Ultimately, we receive from it what we put in. May these 40 days serve as a grace filled opportunity to grow in our faith and devotion to the Lord!



- MASS CARDS FOR UNANNOUNCED MASSES: You can give a Mass card to mark a memorial or intention that will be an "unannounced" Mass, meaning that Fr. McMahon would celebrate the Mass either privately or when there is no intention scheduled. Mass cards are available by contacting the inter-parish office during regular office hours.
