From the Pastor



Dear Parishioners,

Welcome to Lent! We are now embarking on a sacred 40 day journey of prayer and penance. As is the usual pious custom, many of us sacrifice something we enjoy for Lent. This is a traditional spiritual practice that assist us in battling the inclination towards sin. However, we should not only consider "giving up" something but also "giving back" to the Lord. Perhaps giving Him a few extra minutes a day in prayer or attending daily Mass? Praying the Stations of the Cross is also a spiritually enriching way to enter into this season. We begin this Monday at 6PM at St. Theresa's Church.

Next weekend, every parish in the diocese is required to conduct the "in-pew" solicitation for the 2018 Catholic Charity Fund Appeal. Simply, for those wishing to contribute, envelopes will be available in the pews and can be either dropped in the collection basket or mailed to either parish. Please indicate which parish to credit. Ideally, a modest increase of \$2 or \$3 would be sufficient in helping us get through the next several weeks. A little goes a long way! Both St. Theresa and OLGH Churches are God's house and thus, we all share in the burden of maintaining what God has generously bestowed to us! As always, I am grateful for your fidelity and devotion to our two wonderful parishes!
