**Dear Parishioners,**

Please welcome Fr. Cosmas Nwosuh, MSP who is visiting our parishes this weekend on behalf the annual missionary appeal, the Missionary Society of St. Paul. Father Cosmas will preach and celebrate all Masses. The Missionary Society of St. Paul (MSP) is a congregation of priests founded in Nigeria in 1977. The Society now has 260 priests. They are working in ten countries of Africa, (South Africa, Malawi, Botswana, Cameroon, Liberia, Chad, The Gambia, Nigeria, Kenya and Southern Sudan), Grenada in the West Indies, the United States, England, Sweden and Ireland. They also have about 127 seminarians in their seminary in Nigeria.

At the heart of the mission of "MSP" is to minister and preach the Good News to the world's most impoverished. For example, their mission center in the nation of Malawi provides rehabilitation and support for over 300 orphans who lost their parents due to AIDS. They rely on our financial assistance in order to continue this mission. They also need funds to: 1) provide fresh water wells, and education in rural communities of Chad, Malawi, South Sudan, Kenya and Nigeria; 2) Sponsoring seminarians, our future priests; 3) Supporting priests in the founding/building of new churches. Your support to this worthy cause will be an immense encouragement to the Missionary Society of St. Paul to as they continue to take the good news to those desperately in need of it. The second collection taken up this weekend is designated to the work of the Mission of St. Paul!

Next weekend is the "Bi-annual OLGH Yard Sale", held in the basement and grounds of OLGH Church in Mapleville. Several parishioners, who are moving into new homes, have unloaded many wonderful items this year. Stop by, there is bound to be many bargains and hidden treasures to be found!
