From the Pastor


Dear Parishioners,

We seldom view our ordinary work as being the work of God. We cannot always see the direct connection of our daily work to the plan of God. But we trust and we believe that God leads us to do what is needed, where it is needed. What is "God's work?" "This is the work of God, that you believe in the one he sent" (John 6:29).
