# From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

The annual parishioner's financial report for the 2017/18 Fiscal Year for both Our Lady of Good Help and St. Theresa parishes are available this weekend. The trustees, auditors and finance councils of each respective parish corporation approved the reports last month and was forwarded to the Diocese. Located in the back of each church are copies of the profit and loss sheets, as well as a brief summary letter explaining the financial status of each parish for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018.

As you are well aware, every parish is very much dependent on the weekly budget in order to remain solvent. (There are no secret subsidies given to us by the *Vatican or the Diocese!*) Your weekly support ensures that each parish makes payroll and pays the basic operational bills. Essentially, we run a fairly "bare bones no frills" operation here. However, both communities also need to meet the average weekly budget target of at least \$3,500 to maintain what we have. Like your household, expenses mount quickly. Consider that each parish consists of three buildings that need to be heated and maintained, as well as a cemetery. We employ two full-time employees with benefits (who are also shared by both parishes), as well as seven part-time employees (religious education, book-keeper & music ministry). My salary and benefits are split by both parishes. To give an example of an uncontrollable expense, it cost \$1,200 last month to just inspect and repair the elevator at St. Theresa's Church. (Only one company in the area is equipped to do this service and is required by law.) The good news is both parishes are solvent overall, but this has been chiefly accomplished because both parishes have combined resources. To ensure our long term viability, we must now seriously consider a broader vision, as the lack of available of priests and aging demographics dictate a changing reality. If we, as a church, do not adjust and prepare for the future, many parishes (including ours) will not be sustainable in the long term.

I am most grateful for your generosity, love and devotion to your parishes. It is only because of your sacrificial giving that we are here. I recognize that many parishioners face financial burdens in and do their very best to support their church. Ultimately, all of us share in the responsibility of keeping our Churches maintained and mot importantly, spiritually alive!
