Dear Parishioners,

Have you ever considered serving the Lord as a lector, Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion or altar server? We need your help! Last weekend in my homily, I addressed the various needs and challenges facing our parishes. Be that as it may, we are in need of parishioners to become involved in various liturgical ministries at both OLGH & St. Theresa Parishes.

How does one go about becoming a lector? All that is required is that one is a Confirmed Catholic in good standing, possess reverence for proclaiming the Word of God and not afraid to speak in public. (For those who may be intimidated, like anything, the more you do it the easier it becomes!) Although we do have a healthy number of lectors, we could use more! Regarding service as an Extraordinary Minister (a.k.a Eucharistic Minister), one must also be a confirmed Catholic in good standing who is willing to reverently assist with the distribution of Holy Communion during Holy Mass. We are also in need of ministers to visit our homebound parishioners and those residing in local nursing homes (Bayberry Commons & Pine Grove Health Center).

Regarding altar servers, children who have received their First Communion though high school are eligible. Many of our faithful servers are approaching graduation from high school and will be heading off to college. We now only have about 15 servers. However, many of our high school servers now have jobs and conflicting activities that makes it difficult for them to fulfill the schedule. Ideally, it would be great to increase the roster by at least 10 new servers this year! The need is now especially greatest at the 4:30 PM Vigil Mass on Saturdays.

If you are interested in serving in any of the aforementioned ministries, please contact me to make arrangements. Please remember, to serve the Church in any capacity is an honor and privilege that will bestow many blessings for you and your family!
