This week is designated as "Catholic Schools Week" across the Diocese and the nation. Many of us (especially "older" parishioners) are products of Catholic education. Schools were a staple in virtually every parish until the last several decades. (*To think, both OLGH and St. Theresa had full functioning schools from Grades K through middle school up until the 1970's!*) These schools were staffed by religious congregations who worked for little or no pay, as tuition virtually cost nothing (by today's standards). Of course, circumstances changed rather rapidly in the years since Vatican II. Parish based schools and the education they provide are now considered luxuries, as many parish schools have been forced to close over the years.

However, there are still some affordable quality catholic education options in the Northern Rhode Island region. Our parishes are members of the "Greater Woonsocket Catholic Regional School System", which serves Northern RI with a wonderful faith-based education. The GWCRS consists of two schools: Msgr. Gadoury School (located near Park Square adjacent to Our Lady Queen of Martyrs Church building in Woonsocket offering Grades Pre K-2) and Good Shepherd School (Grades 3-8 located adjacent to St. Joseph Church on Mendon Road in Woonsocket). Currently, we have approximately ten families from both parishes enrolled in the system. We do have some limited funds available to assist families with tuition expenses if need be.
