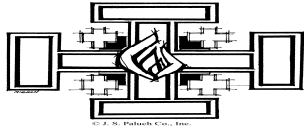

## From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Please welcome Sister Emerita McGann, a Sister of Divine Providence in Kentucky, who will speaking at all Masses at OLGH/St. Theresa this weekend for the annual Missionary Appeal. Interestingly, The Sisters of Divine Providence staffed Our Lady of Good Help School Mapleville until the 1970's! A native of Rhode Island, Sister Emerita was scheduled to be with us last year, but was unable to travel due to the pandemic restrictions that were in place. The second collection will be taken for the appeal on behalf of the missions of her congregation in Madagascar. (Please note, St. Patrick's had their mission appeal last month, before we were affiliated).

There is an old adage "everything runs its course." Due to the ramifications of the pandemic, transitions in leadership, and the lack of volunteer base, we will not be offering the August Shrine Feast Day this year or in 2022. The Feast Day enjoyed a wonderful 26 year run under the leadership of the late Mr. Jerry Finelli, who essentially created the Feast as we have known it. While Rhode Island has lifted gathering limits, the aforementioned factors, and the lack of time for adequate planning this year, make this an increasingly more difficult endeavor to pull off.

However, there will be the continued focus on creating new devotional events and retreat days in the months ahead under the leadership of our new directress, Mrs. Silvia Aldredge. We are also beginning to plan for the 100th Anniversary of the establishment of St. Theresa's Shrine in 2023, with various events to commemorate this significant milestone. Also, we are anticipating a potential visit from a significant figure in the American Catholic Church, to be announced once confirmed!

Lastly, over the past several weeks, the Shrine Bookstore has been undergoing a significant retooling with the hopes of establishing regular hours soon. Please check it out! Also, the work to repair the Holy Stairs is nearly complete. These are the first of several projects that are on the docket at our beloved shrine!
