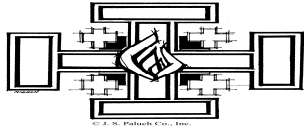

We are now officially in the Fall season, truly a beautiful time of year in New England. Fall also begins the "busy" season in the life of our parishes.
