Sunday, June 22, 2025– The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

Corpus Christi is the celebration of the abiding presence of a loving God as Emmanuel – God with us. This feast gives us the opportunity to grow in our awareness of Jesus' living presence in the Holy Eucharist, and to give collective thanks to our Lord for his living with us in the Eucharist. The feast also gives us an occasion to learn more about the importance and value of the "Real Presence" on Jesus' body and blood, soul and Divinity under the appearances of bread and wine, so that we may appreciate the Sacrament better and receive maximum benefit from the Eucharist.

The real presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist happens through the process of "Transubstantiation" which means that the substance of the consecrated bread and wine is changed into the substance of the risen Jesus' glorified Body and Blood by the action of the Holy Spirit, while its accidents (like color, shape, taste etc.), remain the same.

Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist both as a sacramental banquet and a sacrificial offering. As a Sacrament, the Eucharist is a visible sign that gives us God's grace and God's life and, as a Meal, the Eucharist nourishes our souls. Secondly, as a sacrifice, the Eucharistic celebration is a re-presentation or re-enactment of Jesus' sacrifice on Calvary, completed in His Resurrection. In the Eucharistic celebration, we offer Jesus' sacrifice to God the Father for the remission of our sins, using signs and symbols.

The Holy Eucharist is the source and summit of our life together as the Church. The Council of Trent (1545 to 1563) declared that we must honor Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist publicly so that those who observed the Faith of Catholics in the Most Holy Eucharist might be attracted to the Eucharistic Lord and believe in the Divinity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, present in this great Sacrament. "The Catholic Church teaches that in the Eucharist, the Body and Blood of the God-man are really, truly, substantially, and abidingly present together with his soul and divinity by reason of the Transubstantiation of the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ. This takes place in the unbloody sacrifice of the Mass" (Council of Trent, 1551; CCC # 1374, note 200)

By receiving Holy Communion, let's become Christ-bearers as Mary was, by conveying Christ to others at home and in the workplace, through love, mercy, forgiveness and humble and sacrificial service.

Our Lady of Good Help is the United States' first and only approved Marian Apparition. In 1859, the Blessed Mother appeared to a young woman named Adele Brise, introducing herself as the "Queen of Heaven who prays for the conversion of sinners." Adele would go on to found a community of teaching sisters and her cause for canonization is making it's way through the Vatican's process. St. Patrick, (feast day, March 17), is the patron saint and national apostle of Ireland. He is credited with bringing Christianity to Ireland and is probably significantly responsible for the Christianization of the Picts and Anglo-Saxons who inhabited Ireland in the 4th and 5th centuries. Patrick is known from two short works, [the Confessio](#), a spiritual autobiography,

and his Letter to Coroticus, a

denunciation of British mistreatment of Irish Christians.

The parish encourages all Catholics to take the time to read The Confessio. At only 65 paragraphs or 'chapters' it is a remarkable work for it's economy of prose and the powerful, even searing, self-reflection of it's author.

We strongly encourage every family of the parish to consider making a pledge to this fund drive.



Regardless of the dollar amount raised, we hope for 100% participation by our parishioners.
