

## FROM THE PASTOR

Sunday, April 14th, 2024  
The Third Sunday of Easter

The nature of men and women, generally, is for us to want to see ourselves as the smartest, most beautiful or handsome, most intelligent, good etc. etc., even if we may, in fact, be engaged in lazy, idle, ugly, foolish, and wicked behavior. And so often, blinded by our own pride, we may even come to view everybody else as good for nothing!

If everybody could look into a kind of mirror where we could see clearly and completely, our own mind, body, soul, feelings, emotions, attitudes, habits, addictions etc. and the effects and impacts they have on our own lives and in the lives of others; I am sure, that no person would ever be the same! If everyone was able to have such a realistic inner vision, this world would be radically changed! Such a world would be a paradise!

We have just completed our yearly celebrations of Holy Week, the passion, death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ! The New Testament Bible now turns to the apostles and other disciples, after receiving the Holy Spirit, out in the world proclaiming the Good News. This proclamation is something similar to inviting us all to look into that magic mirror, accept the reality of our lives, accept our penance and be redeemed, bathed in the light of Christ the Redeemer.

The focal point of all three readings for this third Sunday of Easter is "repentance and believing in the Crucified Christ". The First reading from the Acts of the Apostles, gives us Peter's second sermon addressing the assembly of the Hebrews at the Portico of Solomon in Jerusalem. Peter forcefully shows how the messianic prophecies have been fulfilled in the crucified and risen Christ, Jesus and challenges the Hebrews to repent and turn toward God so that their sins may be wiped away. In the Second reading, St. John answers doubts raised by the heretics of his time, asserting the fundamental Christian doctrine that Jesus' death was a sacrifice offered as expiation for our sins.

The Gospel today, describes Jesus' appearance on the evening of His Resurrection to his apostles who were in the locked Upper Room, the Cenacle. Jesus addressed them removing the apostles doubts regarding his Resurrection by inviting them to touch him and by eating a piece of cooked fish. Jesus explains how the prophecies have been fulfilled in him. Then he commissions them to bear witness to him and preach "repentance and forgiveness of sins in his name" after receiving the Holy Spirit.

Like the early disciples, we can avail the light of Christ to really 'see' ourselves. Let us come to know who we are and what we really should be. And with repentant and renewed hearts, let us live and share Christ's message!






## Diocesan News and Events
