

This weekend we celebrate the 99th anniversary of the founding of St. Theresa's Shrine in Harrisville/Burrillville, Rhode Island, as the First Shrine of St. Theresa of Lisieux in the world. The Shrine in Burrillville was founded in August 1923, yes, have no doubt, two years before she was canonized.

This Sunday's Responsorial Psalm (Ps 117) "Go out to all the world and tell the Good News," reflects the mission of God's chosen people to be instruments of salvation to the whole world. Living and remaining in the cloistered cells of her convent, having travelled no where in the world to preach or evangelize, she became the Patron of Missions and missionaries. And a true instrument in the hands of God for the salvation of many souls.


Through the second reading, exploring the consequences of Christian commitment, St. Paul explains that "the narrow gate" of Jesus means our accepting pain and suffering as the loving discipline God is giving His children. Think of St. Theresa's life full of continued sickness and suffering which she transformed into her "little way" to "Perfection" and "Holiness".

Jesus is very clear when he says that anyone who follows him through the narrow gate of sacrificial service and sharing love will be saved.

St. Theresa's words should inspire us, "...despite my littleness I can aspire to holiness. It is impossible for me to grow up, I must put up with myself as I am, with all my imperfections; but I want to find how to get to Heaven by a little way that is quite straight, quiet short; a completely new little way."

Theresa embraced the narrow way, the narrow gate by her love, sacrifice, penance and all the more her committed life of prayer for the Church, for the missions, for the whole world. Hence, she obtained salvation for her and for many souls, and continues to win souls through her miraculous aid from heaven.


## Rosary Walk

Fr. Parathanal recently gave a presentation on the new Rosary Walk for the Shrine. The preliminary estimate for the walk itself is \$181,000. He envisions ten granite monuments, each with a mystery on both sides. So one could walk the outside walkway and encounter the five Joyful and five Sorrowful mysteries, or walk the inside walkway and encounter the five Glorious and five Luminous mysteries. The projected cost for each monument is approximately \$10,000 and would be a great memorial for a deceased relative or friend. He projects construction for early next Spring and dedication at the 100th anniversary celebration in the Summer of 2023. 


A sketch of the proposed monuments in the new Rosary Walk. One side will have a Joyous/Glorious mystery and the other a Sorrowful/Luminous mystery.
