Dear Parishioners,

This past Monday, I met with members of the newly created parish building advisory committee regarding projects and priorities at both church properties and cemetery. Frankly, it is a monumental task to maintain a combined six buildings, an expansive outdoor shrine and a small cemetery. There is always much to be done! Thankfully, our parish buildings and landscapes are in fairly good structural shape overall, considering each structure is nearly 100 years old. However, it takes a parish wide effort to maintain and improve upon what we have. Keep in mind, there are only so many funds within our annual budget the that can be committed to projects and improvements each year. Also, we are dependent on the availability of contractors, various diocesan regulations, and the already busy schedule of Ken Garrepy (our building and grounds coordinator) to accomplish various projects. So.....your parish needs your help too!

Although we have a few faithful volunteers who assist with maintaining the grounds at each church, there are some projects that may need some extra help. One project in particular is the need to improve St. Theresa's Convent, which is in need of interior painting. The paint is peeling on many ceiling areas and walls throughout the building. (It has not been painted in decades!) Furthermore, the interior carpeting is well worn in need of replacement. If you have the expertise and would be willing to assist or donate to this effort, please contact the parish office.

Also an update on a few projects completed and forthcoming: (1) Several dying trees and overgrown brush was cut down by several volunteers at St. Theresa's shrine last weekend, near the parking lot. This will provide for a "cleaner look." It is proposed that "a Garden of St. Therese" will occupy that site. (2) The water pump at St. Theresa was struck by lightning and needed immediate replacement. A claim is being pursued with the diocesan insurance company. (3) The OLGH parking lot is in need for the cracks to be sealed filled. This must be done every three years and will be completed in the early Fall. (4.) We are discussing plans to erect a permanent gate at St. Theresa Cemetery to help secure the property in the coming months. (We have had ongoing issues with trespassing and questionable activities on our cemetery land.) The gate should help alleviate this problem. I will keep you updated on these and many other projects on the docket!


