From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Please extend a warm welcome to Fr. Paul John, who is visiting our parishes this weekend on behalf of the annual missionary appeal. Father Paul will preach at all Masses. Father is representing the Archdiocese of Pondicherry and Cuddalore, India, a missionary diocese that faces extreme poverty. Father Paul is native of India, but currently ministers in the Archdiocese of New York at St. Barnabas Parish in the Bronx. The second collection this weekend is designated to support their mission of evangelization and serving the poor in India.

Today is the Feast of Corpus Christi. The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that: *"The Eucharist is 'the source and summit of the Christian life.' The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesial ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself." (1324).*

The Eucharist constitutes *"the Church's entire spiritual wealth, that is, Christ Himself, our Pass-over and living bread. It is the "Sacrament of Sacraments" and through it "the work of our redemption is accomplished."* Jesus Christ who is the "living bread that came down from heaven" assures us that *"whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink."* As we celebrate this feast, let us do so with great faith, devotion and solemnity. Thus, we should never take the gift of the Holy Eucharist for granted!

I am away this weekend on my annual retreat, but will return later on this week. All of you will be remembered in my prayers during my time away.
