Dear Parishioners,

Time marches on, doesn't it? We are already approaching the summer season, in my opinion, the best time of year! Not only do we experience warm weather, but also the summer refreshes us mentally, spiritually and physically! Summer serves as an opportunity to enjoy the outdoors, travel and most importantly, spend quality time with family and friends. But in these months of recreation, let us not forget about God! Both churches are open all summer for Masses!

With the impending "merger" of OLGH & St. Theresa in less than one month, some have questioned the meaning of the phrase "mission status" as it relates to St. Theresa Church & Shrine. According the Code of Canon Law (the official law of the Church promulgated by Rome), a mission church is the "other" sacred building where Masses and liturgical services occur in a merged parish. Another way to look at it, a mission is the church property where the parish priest does not reside.

Since on July 1st, the parishes will be unified, the parish membership is under the umbrella of "Our Lady of Good Help Parish & St. Theresa Shrine", it means that the parishioner census and finances will be combined under one corporation. To reiterate, St. Theresa Church building and Shrine retain their identity, as does the OLGH Church building. There has been some confusion circulating that the merger means closure of our church. Masses will continue as is now, as there is no pastoral or financial need to close either building.

Remember, we are becoming one parish, two churches and campuses beginning July 1st. If anything, more activity will be taking place at St. Theresa, as the office, shrine, and parish hall will remain there despite the change in the "parish status." Spread the word!
