**Dear Parishioners**,

Congratulations to the children from Our Lady of Good Help and St. Theresa's who received their first Holy Communion today (Sunday)! I am grateful to our Religious Education Coordinators, Pat Ducharme and Janet Badzmierowski, as well as our dedicated Second Grade Teachers Michelle Poirier and Jennifer Bodziony for their patient dedication. Our children were well instructed. Every year, I am impressed by their enthusiasm and reverence.

This Tuesday, we welcome Auxiliary Bishop Robert Evans to Our Lady of Good Help Church for the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation at 6:30 PM. Nearly 40 candidates from our parishes will receive the grace and gifts of the Holy Spirit through the conferral of the sacrament. The Baltimore Catechism states that at Confirmation, one is given the grace to become a "solider for Christ." In recent decades, this concept has been lost by some, but it is nonetheless still very true! The Baltimore Catechism defines a sacrament as "a visible sign of an invisible reality in order to give us arace." (Perhaps the best definition there is!) 
