As you are well aware, in conjunction with the Diocese of Providence, our parish is now participating in the Grateful for God's Providence Capital Campaign. To reiterate, this is a Diocesan initiative (similar to Catholic Charities) in which every parish is required to participate. Please keep in mind any mailings you receive originates from the campaign office and is part of the overall process.

Nonetheless, this weekend, our parish chairperson, Lorraine O'Rourke, will be speaking briefly at all Masses to provide more information on our involvement in the campaign.
