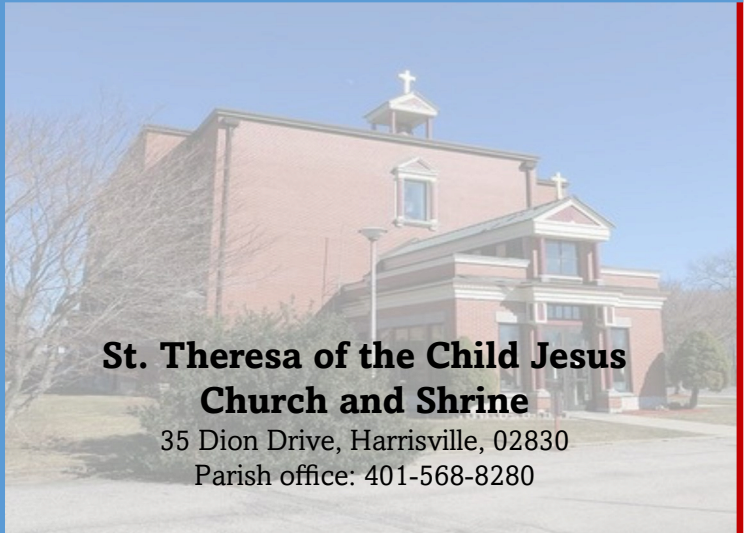

Sunday, July 6, 2025— The 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Church is missionary by its very nature. The Father sent His only Son, Jesus to this world to save humanity through His passion, death and resurrection. By proclaiming the Good News of the love and mercy of God, after death, but before ascending to the Father, Jesus entrusted His disciples to continue to proclaim the Good News of God's love, mercy and redemption.

The Scriptures announce this Good News. They remind us that sharing the Good News of the Kingdom by words, deeds and through our example is not the task of only a few. Rather, it is the task assigned to all baptized Christians.

When Our Lord appointed the 72 and sent them ahead of Him to every town He intended to visit, Jesus gave them some directives regarding their missionary work. The primary aspect of his instruction was to trust and hope in the care of our loving God, especially in the face of struggle, persecution and suffering. He also called on the Disciples to rejoice always for God had great things in store for those who, with cheerful resignation, trust in Him in all matters.

The Prophet Isaiah frequently repeats, "Rejoice, be glad, exult, exult in the Lord, for you will know the power of the Lord."

A beautiful example of this missionary life is that of St. Paul's. The life of Paul after his conversion was one of constant trials, struggles, persecutions, and sufferings in order to preach the Good News of Christ crucified and risen. Paul travelled almost 18,000 miles at a time when there were no modern means of transportation in an era when travelling was not at all safe. This did not stop him, nor he was worried about the dangers he faced. Instead he approached everything with an attitude of rejoicing in his mission, "For to me life is Christ, and death is gain" (Phl. 1:21).

Towards the end of his mission, knowing that his execution was near, Paul was content and happy about his life. He said, "For I am already being poured out like a libation. I have competed well. I have finished the race; I have kept the faith. Now I am ready to receive the crown the Lord has prepared for me" (2 Tim. 4:6-8). With great Joy, St. Paul met his sufferings uniting them with the sufferings of Christ crucified and wishing Peace and Mercy to all who trust in The Lord.

Let us always remember in our daily lives our missionary duty, in spite of the struggles and sufferings, that our God is a God of love and Mercy who promises "Rejoice, your names are written in heaven".

We are also seeking volunteers to assist with classroom cleanup in September.

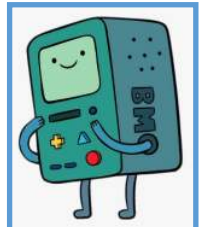


A warm thank-you to all who made a pledge to this year's annual Catholic Charity Appeal. Final numbers for our parish will be published as soon as they are available.
