Credit for Caring Act (S. 3702/H.R. 7165)

The Credit for Caring Act would help eligible working family caregivers offset some of the cost of caregiving expenses. Eligible family caregivers would receive a credit of 30 percent of the qualified expenses paid for or incurred by the family caregiver above \$2,000, up to a maximum credit of \$5,000.

to Medicare Act (S. 3766/H.R. 7274)

Requires CMS to publicize the voluntary option for 1-800-MEDICARE to share a Medicare beneficiary's health information with a family caregiver(s) they choose.

Alleviating Barriers for Caregivers (ABC) Act (S. 3109)

Sens. Ed Markey (D-MA) & Shelley Moore Capito (R-WV)

The ABC Act helps reduce red tape for family caregivers at the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) in Medicare and Medicaid and Social Security Administration (SSA).

Lowering Costs for Caregivers Act (S. 3254/H.R. 7222)

The Lowering Costs for Caregivers Act allows flexible spending account, health savings account, health reimbursement account, and Archer medical savings account funds to be applied to medical expenses for a parent or spouse's parent. Current law already allows you to use FSAs/HSAs to care for a spouse. The Act does not change current authorized medical expenses.
