

PARITY

Motorcyclists' input and consideration must be sought in the development and construction of roadways, signage and road surfaces. Motorcycles must be included in the research, design, development and deployment of new technologies, including but not limited to autonomous vehicles, intelligent driving systems and smart lanes.

INCENTIVES

Motorcycling offers considerable benefits to our nation's infrastructure. To maximize these benefits, legislation should seek to incentivize motorcycling by exempting motorcycles on high-occupancy vehicle (HOV) lanes and toll roads and extending the two-wheel electric vehicle tax credit.

RESEARCH

Motorcycling must be included as a key data set when developing data-driven traffic improvements and infrastructure safety studies. Create a uniform national crash reporting system that includes motorcycle incidents.
