Greenbrier Rezoning Moving Forward in Hilliard

The Hilliard Town Council met Thursday night for their first meeting of 2022. The meeting was opened with Council President John Beasley, "It is with a heavy heart to share that one of our former Hilliard Councilman, Donald Humphrey, passed away this morning (January 6, 2022). Please keep his entire family in your prayers."

Donald served on the Hilliard Planning & Zoning Board from March 2005 – December 2005. He also served as a Hilliard Councilman from January 2006 – December 2013.

The meeting began with the second and final Public Hearing and Reading of Ordinance 2021-09, which was unanimously approved. The ordinance concerns the rezoning of approximately 161 acres of property located on the west side of US Highway 1 to the south of the intersection with Henry Smith Road and west of Old Dixie Road. The property, upon build out, is preparing for 350 single family homes and 70,000 sf of commercial frontage.

The next order of business was to appoint the organization of offices for the 2022 Calendar Year. The council approved leaving all offices and commissioners in the current places which are: Council President and Parks & Recreation Commissioner John Beasley; Council Pro Tem and Street Commissioner

Kenny Sims; Councilwoman and Air Park Commissioner Callie Bishop; Councilman and Water & Sewer Commissioner Lee Pickett; and Councilman and Fire Commissioner Jared Wollitz.

The council approved the reappointment of Charles Reed and Skip Frey to the Planning and Zoning Board for another 3-year term.

The council agreed to have a joint workshop with the Nassau County School Board on Monday, January 10 at Town Hall.

Commissioner of Parks & Recreation John Beasley requested approval of Jasmine Booth temporary to regular part-time employment. Parks & Recreation Director Gabe Whittenburg was unable to attend the meeting due to filling in for a coach for basketball.

The council approved the CDBG Water Main Replacement Change Order No. 3 with an increased price of \$15,088.39 due to addition of a directional drill at the road crossing from change in field conditions.

Resolution 2022-01 was approved which concerned Town of Hilliard 2022 Holidays for employees.

The council also approved five other projects which are ongoing at the Hilliard Airpark. All projects are funded 100% by the FAA and FDOT.

The next meeting of the council will be Thursday, January 20 at 7 p.m.

Winning the gold was the best part of the trip of course," added David. "We had a great tour guide that took us everywhere around Jerusalem. It was just incredible. We learned a lot about

the culture over there and the foods. Before we left, we swapped shirts and caps with other teams. We made some great friends on the trip."

David was just notified that he has made the first roster of 24 for the 2022 trip back to Jerusalem. As a part of that team, he will

travel in February to California where the team will work out in the official Olympic Stadium. The team will also play a game against Mexico in the NFL Experience prior to the Super Bowl. He is super pumped about the opportunity to continue to play at this level.

"I love playing the game. I feel so blessed to be able to enjoy what I do," continued David. "I'm just a competitor!"



FSCJ to Support Commercial Vehicle Driving Program Expansion
