



it every week. The book is a reading book with added coloring activity pages in



for Uncle Frank. The White House did not respond to requests for comment.

As always...that's just my opinion!



NASSAU COUNTY IS ACCEPTING NOMINATIONS OF PROPERTIES FOR POTENTIAL ACQUISITION THROUGH THE CONSERVATION LAND ACQUISITION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (CLAM)

NOMINATION PERIOD FOR THE CURRENT CYCLE ENDS ON JANUARY 31, 2023

Nominations are accepted on a rolling basis.

The Nassau County Conservation Land Acquisition and Management (CLAM) program was created to preserve and conserve the county's natural, historic, and working lands resources by identifying, ranking, and assessing conservation lands for acquisition and management.

During the initial CLAM nomination period, July 24, 2021 through January 31, 2022, over 750 parcels were nominated for inclusion in the CLAM program. Staff completed its evaluation of the nominations and presented its top 25 ranking recommendations to the CLAM Committee. The Committee's final ranking was approved by the Board of County Commissioners on September 26, 2022.

Nominations of properties may be submitted from any person or organization, including the County, nonprofit organizations, and local, regional, state, or federal governmental entities. To nominate a property for potential acquisition, the nominator shall submit an application to the Nassau County Planning Department. Nominators may nominate an entire parcel for acquisition in fee simple or only a specific portion thereof or interest therein. In nominating properties, nominators should consider, at a minimum, the information contained in the Conservation Plan, the CLAM Resource Rankings Map, and the CLAM Manual.

Previously submitted parcels do not need to be resubmitted. All previously submitted nominations remain eligible for consideration.


Nominations must be received by the Nassau County Planning Department no later than 5:00 pm on Tuesday, January 31, 2023. Nominations received after the nomination period will not be considered for the 2023 cycle. What If?

In order to understand the significance of Christmas, one way to do this is ask the "what if" question about Jesus' birth. To be clear, Jesus is eternal. Jesus did not come into existence when he was born in Bethlehem. The Incarnation of Christ is the most unique and mysterious mystery in all of the word. How the second person of the Godhead proceeded through a birth canal? How the Creator of all things, was born in human flesh?

Jesus is God's answer to the problem of forgiveness. You may not have ever thought about forgiveness as being a problem for God. Forgiveness is a problem for God. How could a holy God, who is too pure to look on sin forgive sinful man? How could the sentence of death that all creation is under because of sin, ever be forgiven? How could divine payment and satisfaction for sin ever be paid by mortal man? The answer is that divine wrath cannot be satisfied by sinful man. This is why forgiveness is a problem.

God's answer to the problem of forgiveness, is the Incarnation of Christ. A mere human could not satisfy God's wrath, only God can satisfy God's wrath. In order for God's wrath to be satisfied, God took on flesh in the person of Jesus. Jesus was born in the flesh, he lived a perfect life in bodily form, and he died a sacrificial death as the sinless Son of God. Jesus defeated death, by bodily conquering the grave. As a result of the Incarnation of the Person of Christ, we can be forgiven and have resurrection hope. This is staggering and jaw-dropping love.

So, let's go back to the question at the beginning, what if? What if Jesus would have never been born? The answer is that there would be no hope in this world. As I think about how Paul speaks of the resurrection of Christ and the devastating consequences if Christ is not risen in I Corinthians 15:12-19, the same can be said of the birth of Christ. If there is no birth, there is no sacrificial death, if there is no sacrificial death, there is no resurrection. We cannot sperate Christmas from Easter, because there is not one without the other. If there is no manger, there is no empty tomb. Since Christ came and is risen, we are not in our sins, we are not trapped in the domain of death, we are not hopelessly stuck in a downward spiral decay and death. There is forgiveness, there is new life now, there is salvation, and there is resurrection.

Mr. James Edgar Truett, Sr. celebrated his 100th birthday December 15. Mr. James was born December 15, 1922 in Montgomery County, Georgia to John M. and Lillian Truett. He grew up in Mount Vernon, Georgia hunting and fishing. Mr. Truett is also a US Navy Veteran. He was a Navy Aviation Radioman in WWII aboard a VPB-26 Navy patrol bomber after serving as an instructor training radio/radar personnel at numerous bases. He received a commemoration for his participation in the war as a member of the Patrol Bombing Squadron Twenty Six, a unit of the third Fleet, US Navy.



He married Lillie Mae (Welch) in May 15, 1953. He learned carpentry skills from his father which led him into the construction business following his military service. "Daddy built the house that I came home to from the hospital when I was born. And he also built the house that we moved into in Callahan and the store building," said Beverly T. Scarbrough. "And, together, he and my husband Ray built the home that we now live in today in Folkston."

He built homes, working in construction until becoming a boilermaker in the 50s. He retired from St. Regis Paper Company on the Northside of Jacksonville in 1985. He was the owner/operator of Truett's Mart, a little Mom and Pop convenience store on the corner of Lisa Drive and Lem Turner Road in Callahan from 1973 -1992. They were a very gracious couple and were very loved by the community. They helped many people during this era of their life. He coached Little League baseball when his boys were young and taught Sunday school until the age of 97.

Mr. Truett celebrated his special milestone with a party held in his honor with lots of friends and family at New Life Baptist Church in St. George, where they currently attend services. The Truetts still call Thomas Creek Baptist Church in Callahan their church home! Thank you to all who celebrated with Dad.


