In the Kitchen... Creamy Baked Pork Chops

½ yellow onion, sliced 4 pork chops

1/4 cup water 2 cubes beef bouillon

26 oz. condensed cream of mushroom soup

Preheat the oven to 325°. Place onion slices on the bottom of a glass baking dish. Lay pork chops over onions. Cover chops evenly with condensed soup. Add water and bouillon, breaking up the bouillon cubes to spread flavor. Cover the baking dish with aluminum foil. Bake pork chops, stirring gravy once or twice, until no longer pink in the centers, about 1 hour. An instant-read thermometer inserted into the center of a chop should read at least 145°

Reminded by a Rainbow

Pastor Marvin Lee, Ephesus Baptist Church, Hilliard



It was raining hard, really hard, and it seemed like it would never end. Eventually, however, it did and when the clouds cleared away, there spanning the sky, was a beautiful rainbow. Like most of us, I never cease to be amazed by the beauty of a rainbow. It is a testament to the beauty of nature, and to our mighty creator God who is behind all creation. It is also a constant reminder of the famous Bible story about Noah and the Ark found in Genesis 6-9. The Bible tells us that

mankind had become so wicked that God was grieved that He had ever made them. He decided to bring judgment upon the world. Noah, however, served God, so God brought Noah and his family through the flood in an ark. After coming off the ark, God made this promise: "This is the sign of the covenant I am making between Me and you and every living creature with you, a covenant for future generations. I have set My bow in the clouds and it will be a sign of the covenant between Me and the earth. Whenever I form clouds over the earth and the bow appears in the clouds, I will remember My covenant between Me and you and every living creature of all flesh: water will never again become a deluge to destroy all flesh." Every time we see a rainbow it reminds us that God has been faithful to this promise. It also reminds us that God is Faithful to all His promises and to His children.

There are some interesting facts about a rainbow that highlight this wonderful truth. For one thing, it is said that no two people ever see the same rainbow the same way. Where we are standing, the refraction of the light and other factors, determine our view of the rainbow. That means we all get our own personal view of it. A rainbow just for us! God's promises are that way. They are stated for all of us in Scripture, but then God personally applies them to us individually. This reminds us that God is personally involved in the lives of every one of His children.

Second, a rainbow is actually a circle. We, only see part of it. Some people have actually seen a whole rainbow but most have not. This reminds me that God's promises to us are so vast that we cannot even comprehend them all. In I Corinthians 2:8, Paul the Apostle declares, "But as it is written: What no eye has seen and no ear has heard, and what has never come into a man's heart, is what God has prepared for those who love Him." God's love for us is so vast, His promises so amazing and His plans for us so great we struggle to grasp them.

Finally, a rainbow can be covered by the clouds. Sometimes after it rains the clouds will linger and the sky stays dark, but the rainbow is still there behind the clouds. Sometimes life is this way. Things can seem dark. The struggles are intense. Frustration and even depression can set in. It can even seem like God is distant or not listening and you wonder if He even cares. But like the rainbow behind the clouds, He is there. Watching over you. Caring for you. He has promised to never leave you nor forsake you and He never will. He is faithful to His promises and He will be faithful to every one of His children. The greatest proof of God's faithfulness is seen in Jesus Christ. He promised to send us a Savior and He did. And if God, "did not spare His own Son but offered Him up for us all; how will He not also with Him grant us everything?" Romans 8:32. What a promise that is! God is faithful to His word!

The Barefoot Mailman and Florida's Post Office Murals

Post office murals are visible and enduring symbols of New Deal ideology that provide lasting evidence of governmental art patronage during the Great Depression. Not just for picking up mail or sending packages, during the 1930s post offices offered a place to meet neighbors and catch up on news. In Florida, 16 new post offices were built between 1937 and 1943, and each was decorated with murals or relief sculptures paid for by the Treasury Department's Section of Painting and Sculpture. This presentation discusses the West Palm Beach post office's exciting mural series featuring Florida's "Barefoot Mail Carrier," its subject, and how it fits into the Great Depression's larger mural project.

Keri Watson is an associate professor of art history at the University of Central Florida and co-executive editor for

Panorama: Journal of the Association of Historians of American Art. She is the author of This is America: Re-Viewing the Art of the United States (2023) and editor of the Routledge Companion to Art and Disability (2022). This Florida Talks program is a partnership between Florida Humanities and the Nassau County Public Library System. Funding for this program was provided by Florida Humanities and sponsored in part by the State of Florida, Department of State, Division of Arts and Culture, the Florida Council on Arts and Culture, and the National Endowment for the Arts.
