Boondocks Junction has New Owners


Boondocks Junction Music Hall, in Hilliard, has recently changed ownership. Boondocks, located in downtown Hilliard on Pecan Street, has quite a history to share. The building was owned by Gerald and Daphne Guynn. Gerald inherited the building after his father's passing in 2007. His father was Troy 'Boss Hog' Guynn. Troy was well known in Hilliard as he served as the mayor for 15 years and councilman for four years. "He was a jack of all trades.





It seems like he had his hand in about everything," said Gerald. "He was very talented. He knew vehicles and could work on any."

The actual building was built sometime in the 1900's. The building served as the town's commissary for the pulp industry. It was the place where people came and got their goods. "It was in the town square and a great place for people to socialize," said Daphne.



"The building originally had an upstairs and there were seven rooms

where people could stay," added Gerald. "Looking over at the wall, you can still see where the stairs were. My dad took off the top floor and added the room on the side. He (Troy) planned to build the place back up but instead filled it with his treasures."

basically sat dormant, but was full of stuff for several years. In May 2016, Daphne and Gerald's daughter was getting married and they were looking for a venue. Everything was so expensive to rent, the idea came up to get married in the building. From that time, the family began the process of cleaning out the barn and seeing what was actually in there. With lots of help the building was empty but pretty sad looking. Their daughter had the great idea to pull all the paneling off the walls. It was so nice. The wood was in good shape and the planning began. Gerald handled most of the handy work that needed to be done, while the ladies continued their vision. The wedding was beautiful and once people saw it they were hooked. They began receiving requests and questions about Boondocks.

Bryceville Community Club Holds Last Meeting

On Tuesday, May 17, the Bryceville Community Club held their final meeting. Following is a little history about the club.

The Bryceville Community Club was established in 1987 and just celebrated their 35th year. The club was originally established in order to assist citizens of the Bryceville community if they needed special help such as a ride to a medical appointment, extra food, money, clothing, etc.

Bryceville was a small community then and most of the people knew one another. The founding members included: Donald Surrency, Ethel Holton, Helen Ford, Lenora Jones, Sylvia Alsip, Lula Boyd, Onie Ruth Lallament and Elizabeth Whittemore. Although all of the founders have now passed away, many of their descendants still live in the Bryceville area. At that time, the club met in the volunteer Fire Station on US 301. Bylaws were drawn up for the club and revised in 2006.

Currently, the club has 33 members. Over the years, the club came to be known as a 'must visit' stop on local politician's places to campaign. Prior to the elections, the club would invite persons running in local elections to come and speak to its members. Each person was allowed three minutes to tell who they were and why they were running for a particular office. Constitutional amendments and other items on the ballot were also discussed.

Non-political meetings featured speakers from many different areas of interest. In recent years, the Bryceville Community Club has sponsored the 'Good Citizenship Award' for students at Bryceville Elementary School. The quarterly award was given at each grade level to a student who, although they may not be an "A" student, was a good citizen to their fellow students. The award included a certificate from the club and



They decided to name the building Boondocks Junction Music Hall, in honor of Troy. He loved music and hoped to one day make the building a music hall for concerts. From there, they made a Facebook page and began advertising the Boondocks as a venue for any events. "We have had many weddings, anniversaries, birthday parties, etc." said Daphne. "It kind of went crazy. I never knew so many people were looking for places to have events. We have been so blessed."

In October 2017, Gerald was in a horrific motorcycle accident that almost took his life. The accident left him paralyzed from the waist down. Life has been different but also much more difficult. The Guynns finally decided it was time to try to sell.

Monday the closing was held and the Guynns have turned over the keys for Boondock Junction to Jarred and Brittany Cales. The couple and their sweet daughter, Amelia, are currently living in Yulee. Both have lived in Hilliard previously but really feel like this was a 'God thing' for them

to have the opportunity to purchase this property. "I love hosting and I've thought about having a venue for a while," said Brittany.

"We've always wanted to have a deeper connection with the town of Hilliard and surrounding communities. We decided having the year 1881 part of the venue name would help bring a sense of community, given the historical nature of when Hilliard was officially founded," said Jarred. "Adding 1881 to the word "occasions" is defined as: a particular event with cause. We felt combining the two words, 1881 Occasions, gets at the heart of our mission: Bringing forth a greater sense of community to the Glory of our God. We look forward to serving the community whether it's weddings, birthday parties, community events and so much more!"

All the couples involved were so pleased with their realtor, Jennifer Mezera, who went over and above to make sure all parties involved were happy. They welcomed the transition with ease! Congratulations!

When we are faced with trials in our lives, how do we react? When we think about surrendering to God's will in these trials, what comes to mind? Do we only think about the times when we choose obedience right away and thus can move forward in God's will? Are we honest enough with ourselves to admit when we have chosen rebellion?

Let us face it. There are times when we will not like what the Lord's will for us is during these trials. Not because God's will for


us is bad, but because we think we know better. This is rebellion, no other word for it. Sometimes we do not want to do what He wants us to do. Sometimes we do not want to love on the person He wants us to love on. Sometimes we do not want to go where God tells us to go. We cry out to God saying, "God, you just do not understand! I cannot do that." Jonah found himself in this very situation. Instead of surrender Jonah found himself running from God. Despite his efforts, there was nowhere to go. God is everywhere. This is something that should be comforting to us in our trials. God hears us no matter where we are. We can go to God on our knees and cast our cares at the foot of the Jesus' cross.


