## County Commissioner Bell Arrested for DUI

According to reports, last Tuesday, June 21 at approximately 5:30 p.m., Nassau County Commissioner Chair, District 2, Aaron Bell was arrested for Driving Under the Influence. A Fernandina Beach Police Officer pulled Bell over on Sadler Road after observing his vehicle weave within its lane and drive over the marked lanes. Bell told the officer he had just dropped his daughter off at a church function prior to being pulled over. Bell also did not have his driver's license with him.

When asked by the officer if he had been drinking, Bell answered, "No". The officer added that Bell appeared lethargic, confused and disoriented. The

officer was wearing a body cam and the entire incident was recorded.

Bell told the officer, "My wife knows you."

In the video, you hear the officer ask, "Who is your wife?"

Bell replied, "Sarah Bell."

The officer replied, "The assistant state attorney Sarah Bell is your wife?"

Bell answered, "Yeah." Bell was read his rights, then asks the officer, "Can you get me home?"

The officer replied, "No. Why are you different than anyone else I do a DUI investigation with? Because of who your wife is? It don't work that way bud." He continues, "You are not



privileged because of what your wife does for a living." Bell was asked to

recite the alphabet but failed to recite it properly. Bell also refused a breath, blood or urine test at the jail.

When Bell refused to submit to a breath test, he stated, "That's what my wife told me to do."

At the Monday, June 27, County Commission meeting, Commissioner Bell read a prepared statement and stated he would be relinquishing his remaining term as Chairman. The board members approved Commissioner Jeff Gray (District 3) to serve as Chairman of the board and Commissioner Klynt Farmer (District 5) to serve as Vice Chair.

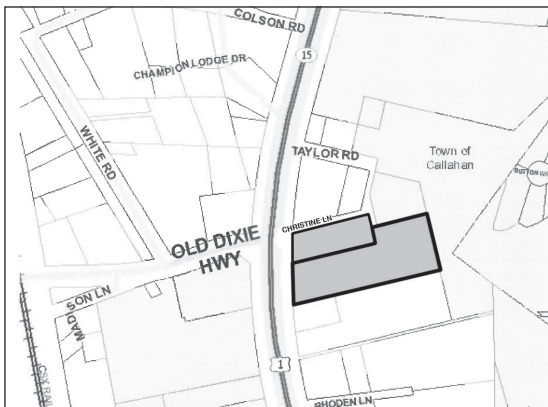

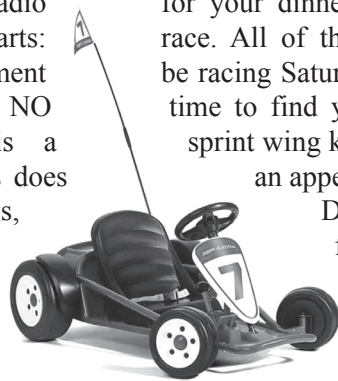

## All Classes Running Saturday at Callahan Speedway

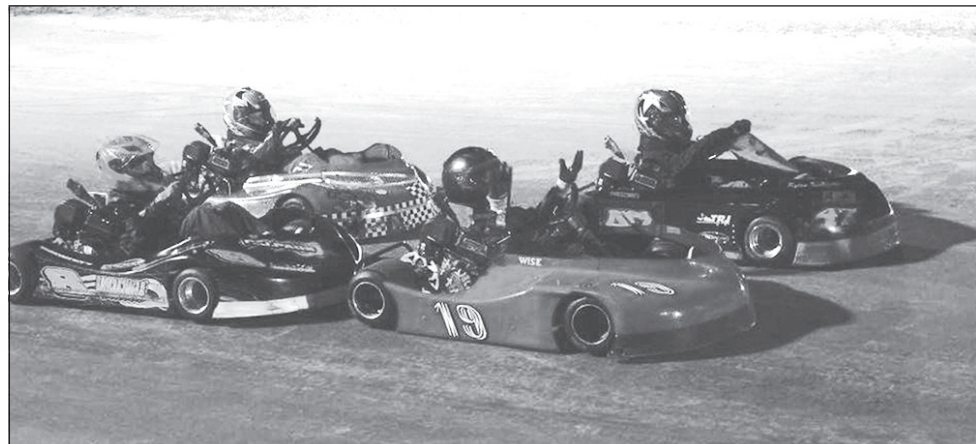
