Brandies Ace Hardware Celebrates 75 Years in Callahan

This year, 2020, Brandies Ace Hardware will celebrate their 75th Anniversary in business here in Callahan. Brandies has been a longtime name to many for years and now we know the reason why. To celebrate 75 years in the same town and same location is quite a feat. The actual anniversary day is July 5, 2020. The store officially opened July 5, 1945.

The store was founded by the family matriarchs, Cliff and Lucille Brandies. Mr. Brandies worked for Seaboard Railroad and traveled quite a bit. He was raised in his home in Callahan in what is now a part of Callahan Funeral Home. He bought the group of buildings, where Brandies currently is, when he was young. At that time, the buildings housed a movie theatre, pool hall, boxing ring, etc. When Cliff and Lucille married they lived in a

small apartment above the last building in the group. Cliff continued to work for the railroad and took Lucille with him when he traveled. Later, the couple, now with two daughters, moved to Fernandina for a short while. In 1944, now with a third daughter, they moved back to Callahan in the apartment above the current store and

started working on the now vacant building for a hardware/appliance store.

The family worked cleaning the store and preparing for merchandise. "I can remember many of the shelves were made from old ammunition boxes," said Patricia Brandies Fachko. "The building was broken into many rooms. Daddy knew what he wanted in each room."

The store officially opened July 5 1945. They sold a variety of hardware and

during the summer. "We were a very close family and we knew what we were supposed to do," said Kay Brandies Coleman. Stokes 'We got our share of spankings too, but we learned from it!"

After the girls graduated from high school, they

> daughters, the Brandies worked tirelessly to make this new adventure work. "Mama would go upstairs and fix lunch each day," added Ann Brandies Hagan.

> "Mama would even invite the salesmen to eat dinner and she cooked it all," continued Patricia.

later married and moved into the upper apartments beside their parents. "I remember that Ann and I still worked in the store and Kay would clean our apartments for us," said Patricia.

Ann's future husband Don (Hagan) began working at the store when he was in 10th grade. Don would go deliver materials to customers. He would also help them with plumbing and some wiring problems.

The girls shared that some of the antiques in store were given by customers to display. Most of the others the Brandies purchased when they made trips to North Carolina antiquing! Looking around the

walls is like stepping back into history. Such a cool place to visit and purchase your necessary hardware!

Around 1963, each of the girls and their husbands moved into their private homes and out of the apartment. Patricia's husband, Donald Fachko, was a contractor and built all the warehouses in the back of the store that covers the lumber. He also built new office spaces for the employees. Today, the girls remain close and all live in Callahan.

Currently, Raymond Fachko, Patricia's son is the manager/co-owner of Brandies Ace Hardware. He has been employed at the store for over 40 years. The three daughters, Ann, Patricia and Kay have shares in the company. When Mrs. Brandies passed away (at 98) Raymond purchased her share making him a partner also.

Raymond, like his mother, grew up in the store. He recalls times that he and his cousin Bill (Hagan) would play on the front porch of the apartment by themselves. "Now that I look at it, that's pretty high



up. But we didn't care we just were having fun," said Raymond. "Grandaddy gave us some nails and hammers and we would just lie on the porch and nail all day. It drove the neighbors crazy but we had fun. We had

"Once I was 16 I worked fulltime here," recalls Raymond. "I learned so many organizational skills from granddaddy and my dad. I also learned that

most knowledge comes from the customers and their situations. That's one of the things I love about working here. Meeting people and listening to what they need and helping them. Many times I learn from them about things!"

So many things have changed over the years and Raymond has been right in the middle of many of those changes. In the old days, they used to have to travel to Jacksonville early and buy wholesale hardware; now everything is delivered. They used to have sand and gravel delivered by train and the cars were unloaded with shovels. Yes, the train came through and delivered it.

Raymond has been a very giving person to our community. If ever there is a need, you will always hear that Brandies Ace

Hardware was right there to help out. For the last three or four years, Brandies has offered a walking fieldtrip for the second grade students at Callahan Elementary. Lucky for me, I have enjoyed a few of those fieldtrips. The history is also told and his grandparents and parents are always mentioned. 
projects to take home. It's such a special

Then...Defund Law Enforcement and abolish Police.


We are all being played by those who want to destroy America! This is how you destroy a Nation from within and in very short order. Will it work; I guess that depends on you and me.

God Is Able

Pastor Marty Paparo, Friendship Alliance Church, Callahan



This week, in our church, we concluded a study that took us just over one year. For most of the Sundays over the past year, we have studied the book of Romans. This week we finished chapter 16. We saw the last words that Paul wants to leave with the church in Rome. Thus far, Paul spent 11 chapters giving the most systematic explanation of the Gospel we will find in Scripture. Then He spends the remainder of the book to share application of those theological truths.

So after all this great writing, what does Paul leave us with? Here it is (and I believe it is just what we need): "Now to him who is able to strengthen you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery that was kept secret for long ages but has now been disclosed and through the prophetic writings has been made known to all nations, according to the command of the eternal God, to bring about the obedience of faith— to the only wise God be glory forevermore through Jesus Christ! Amen." (Romans 16:25-27, ESV)

Here Paul gives us one sentence with three 'accordings' in the middle. The sentence is: "Now to him who is able to strengthen you...to the only wise God be glory forevermore through Jesus Christ! Amen."

And the three "accordings" are: according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery that was kept secret for long ages but has now been disclosed and through the prophetic writings has been made known to all nations, and according to the command of the eternal God, to bring about the obedience of faith. Paul is saying according to these three things or in accordance with these three things, God is able to strengthen you and to Him belongs the glory.

In these crazy times we find ourselves in, it is easy to feel out-of-control. But God is able to strengthen us, to establish us. We can rely on Him. Sometimes we forget how great God is. We used to have a saying around a church I served in years ago: "Don't tell God how big your problems are, tell your problems how big your God is." We serve an incredible God, a very able God. In the face of all the problems we see around us, our job is to simply place our faith in Him; the kind of faith that produces obedience and follows where He leads.

For the last few years, the Callahan Town Council has voted to not have their first meeting in July due to the July 4th holiday. This year is no different. The next regular meeting of the council will be Monday, July 20 at 7 p.m.

As many read in the paper or have heard, at the last meeting of the council, Callahan Mayor Marty Fontes resigned his position as Mayor effective immediately. Town Attorney Jeb Branham searched the town charter for direction and found none when the mayor resigns or leaves his position early. So per Attorney Branham, Council President and Fire Commissioner Ken Bass will serve as Interim Mayor until such time that the town hires a new



one. Currently, with the 'State of Emergency' with the county and town, the town cannot advertise or hire a mayor until the 'emergency' is over.

Mr. Ken Bass is currently serving his second term on the council and second term as Council President. "I

enjoy serving on the council because I love this town," said Bass. "I never intended to be Mayor but I will do my best to serve my town as long as necessary."

In the November General Election, the Callahan Council will have three seats up for election. Those seats include: Councilman Ken Bass, Councilman David Mellecker and Councilwoman Shirley Graham.



Sheriff would wait to take office until January of the following year. As there had been no elected Sheriff in place at the time, Sheriff Geiger was put in office early.

In 2004, Sheriff Geiger decided not to seek another term and ended his final term in office on January 3, 2005. He was the kind of Sheriff that you felt comfortable talking to but you also felt confident he would help you in a minute. He was a man of honor. He had an incredible work ethic and innate ability to lead. He left a godly legacy for

generations to come because he was a man of action, not just words. Nassau County will never forget his dedication and service.




