The Hilliard Town Council met Thursday night for their first meeting of August. The first order of business was the second and final reading of Ordinance 2022-02. The ordinance concerns amending Chapter 62 Zoning and Land Development Regulations of the Hilliard Town Code; creating Section 62-281 and amending Section 62-289 to implement revised permitted uses and permitted uses by exception in the Commercial District. The council

The following two items were tabled until the next meeting.

approved the ordinance.

The next item concerned a Capital Budgeted item for Town Hall Renovations. New workstations are needed due to the old ones falling apart and inadequate to take on the increased workload. Flooring is coming up in all rooms due to water coming up through the slab. This also damaged the existing carpet in several areas. The existing flooring will need to be sealed before new flooring is installed. All walls need fresh paint due to age of existing paint and new construction. The cost for the

renovations is \$70,000 and estimated to take 6-8 weeks.

Council President Beasley asked, "The office will still remain open through the renovations, correct?"

"Yes sir. We will continue to work as normal as possible," said Town Clerk Lisa Purvis.

The council approved the renovations.

The next agenda was approved by the council for a payment to Dixon Tree and Lawn Service for Mow number 5 through July 18, moving of Town Right of Ways, in the amount of \$8,750.


The final item was to accept the resignation from the Planning and Zoning Board from Mr. Dallis Hunter. The council approved the resignation.

In closing comments, Councilman Jared Wollitz advised the council that he had talked with Jeffrey Bunch of the Nassau County School Board, concerning building a sidewalk on Ohio Street beside Hilliard Elementary School, because many children walk down that road after school. Wollitz will update the council as he learns more.






