

Jesus is Better Than Anything

We have a saying around our church: JESUS CHANGES EVERYTHING. When you truly meet the God of the universe, the creator of all things, the result is you are changed. You can't interact with such a powerful being and not be changed. It's like if someone came to me and said I was just out on US1 and was struck by an 18-wheeler; I wouldn't believe them. You don't get hit by an 18-wheeler and walk away unchanged. It's too powerful. In the case of Jesus, He changes us for the better.

On Sunday mornings, we preach chapter-by-chapter and verse-by-verse. We just recently started the book of Hebrews. We found that the entire book of Hebrews can be summed up in one sentence: JESUS IS BETTER THAN ANYTHING. The author of Hebrews spends 13 chapters showing that Jesus is superior to: the prophets, the angels, Moses, the Sabbath, and other priests to name a few. The author wants us to know that there is nothing better than Jesus. The key verse can be found in Hebrews 4:14, "Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess." (ESV)

Because Jesus is better than anything, we must hold firm to our faith. The author of Hebrews shares what King Solomon realized in 950 BC: everything is meaningless (Ecclesiastes 1:2, NIV). King Solomon was the wisest man who ever lived (after Jesus). Additionally, he had what our world today would view as everything anyone could ask for. He was rich, ruled a powerful kingdom, and had 1,000 wives and concubines. If he wanted something, he snapped his fingers and someone brought it to him. Unlike the rest of us, he literally had it "all." And his conclusion was that all the riches, all the power, and all the women still left him feeling empty. He walks away saying it's all meaningless. 


