INTRODUCTION

For nearly 100 years, Quivira Council has been providing Scouting to the youth in South Central Kansas. From Wichita Council to Wichita Area Council to Quivira Council, Scouts and Scouters have been the fabric of many communities. Our council's centennial provides a unique opportunity to recognize the many volunteers that have helped to make Quivira Council to what it is today. Quivira Council will be recognizing past and present volunteers and youth with our one in a hundred years award; The Quivirian Award. The Quivirian Award aims to highlight the many Scouts and Scouters that have contributed to the forming, nurturing, and excellence of our council and who, in doing so, inspired others to follow in their footsteps.



This award is a one-time recognition associated with the centennial anniversary of Quivira Council. This recognition is an opportunity to highlight our council's growth and development over the last century and the many individuals who were instrumental to our success. These honorees will serve as exemplars of leadership, and as a model to others as a commitment to excellence as Quivira Council enters its second century. This award can be given posthumously.

MINIMUM CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION

Adult Nomination:

10+ years of service at any level, Unit, District, Council, etc. Service can be past or present. Nominees need not currently reside within the boundaries of Quivira Council.

Youth Nomination:

11-21 years of age and a minimum of 5+ years of service at any level.

SELECTION AND SUBMISSION OF NOMINEES

By May 30th, 2018, anyone that has been or currently is a member of Quivira Council may nominate a scout volunteer or youth for the Quivirian award. The Quivirian Nomination Form must be used for anyone to be considered. After the submission deadline, a committee will review and select the recipients of The Quivirian Award.

RECOGNITION OF QUIVIRIANS

Living nominees selected by our committee will be provided with a certificate and recognition ribbon consisting of a black and gold ribbon and a metallic totem symbolizing the centennial anniversary of Quivira Council. Nominees selected that have passed will be provided with a certificate to their family. The Quivirian Award will be announced after selection at the at the 2018 Encampment, April 21st-23rd, 2018. Recognition will take place at a gathering in the fall during which time a Centennial Time Capsule will also be buried.
