contemporary chronicler, nine million Indians became Catholic in a very short time. In these days when we hear so much about God's preferential option for the poor, Our Lady of Guadalupe cries out to us that God's love for and identification with the poor is an age-old truth that stems from the Gospel itself." *The Mass (Spanish) for Our Lady will be Tuesday, 7:00 p.m. at St. Francis Xavier in Carbondale, with a celebration to follow. All are welcome!*
