

St. Joseph will have May Crowning today! According to Women for Faith and Family, May Crowning is "a Catholic tradition to honor Mary, our Mother, during the month of May by placing on her statue a crown of flowers. This lovely devotional ceremony is held in many parishes and often with Catholic children. The May Crowning gives the children an opportunity to specially honor the Blessed Mother of Jesus, and to give thanks to her for bringing our Savior into the world."



The crowning will also be done in honor and remembrance of
Our Lady of Fatima, who appeared to the three children in Portugal a century ago. Her feast
day falls on the month of May (the 13th), which in itself is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin
