TRINITY SUNDAY!

“Christians are baptized “in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit”. Before receiving the sacrament, they respond to a three-part question when asked to confess the Father, the Son and the Spirit: “I do.” “The faith of all Christians rests on the Trinity.” (CCC232)

The fundamental dogma, on which everything in Christianity is based, is that of the Blessed Trinity in whose name all Christians are baptized. The feast of the Blessed Trinity needs to be understood and celebrated as a prolongation of the mysteries of Christ and as the solemn expression of our faith in this triune life of the Divine Persons, to which we have been given access by Baptism and by the

Redemption won for us by Christ. Only in heaven shall we properly understand what it means, in union with Christ, to share as sons in the very life of God.” (www.catholicculture.org) Next Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. It is also Father’s Day.
